

Whorled Tickseed

This native perennial is an important nectar plant for butterflies and pollinators. The seeds will be eaten by Sparrows, Towhees, Doves and other birds. This plant is great for the beginning and experienced gardener alike. It thrives in dry, rocky soils, tolerating drought and critters. Cut back in August to promote a Fall rebloom. Coreopsis is known to be deer and rabbit resistant.

- Hardiness: Zone 5-8
- Size: 12-18"
- Flower: Bright yellow flowers for 8 weeks or more from Spring into Summer. Deadhead for rebloom.
- Culture: Prefers full sun and well drained soils. Tolerates part sun. Thrives in poor, rocky soil
- Uses: Perennial border, naturalizing, container, songbirds, butterflies, cut flower, deer, rabbit and drought tolerant
