



Charlotte Catholic Foundation STEM Scholarship

Objective:

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated exceptional ability or contributions in a STEM subject at CCHS.

Requirements:

1. The student is required to be a graduating senior who will attend an accredited college or university or an accredited community college within 6 months of graduating from CCHS. In the event the recipient does not fulfill this requirement, the student will forfeit the monetary aspect of the award unless the Scholarship and Grants Committee finds extraordinary circumstances warranting an extension of the 6-month timeframe.
2. Scholarships will be awarded directly to the student's college or university.

Qualifications:

1. The recipient has been a student in good standing while at CCHS (no suspensions).
2. The recipient must have been enrolled at CCHS for at least two (2) years.
3. The recipient must have participated significantly in STEM classes during his/her tenure at CCHS.

Process for Nominations:

Any CCHS STEM class faculty member or counselor may nominate students in the senior class who meet the qualifications for this award. Self-nominations will not be accepted; however, students may complete the written portion of the nomination form in order to provide a complete and thorough record and response to the information requested. The student must then give the form to an eligible nominator for review, signature, and official submission. Nominators may add information and/or comments to the nomination form as desired before submission.

Nominations will open by March 1 and will be due by March 31 each year. Nominations may be submitted to the CCHS Foundation by placing the completed application in a sealed envelope marked "Scholarship Nomination/CCHS Foundation" and handing it in to the Guidance Office receptionist.

Process for Selection:

The Selection Committee will meet to consider the nominations and will choose a scholarship recipient by May 10 each year. The Selection Committee will include:

1. One Department Chairperson from one of the STEM subjects. The Department Chairperson representative should rotate from year to year.
2. One additional faculty member from a STEM subject.
3. One representative from the Guidance Department
4. One representative from the CCHS Foundation Board of Directors
5. A member of the CCHS Administration

Process for Notification and Awarding:

1. The scholarship will be awarded annually at Senior Awards.
2. The recipient must provide the name, address and any account information to the CCHS Alumni Director by June 5 in order to process the award to the college or university.
