What are the dues used for?

In order to keep our beach open and usable for our neighborhood we are required to have insurance, water testing weekly and beach permits. In addition, we pay for membership into the Wequaquet lake association, pay for the beach clean-up so it may be opened in the spring and pay for sand & geese management, floatation buoys, plantings, signs, picnic tables, fencing and property repairs/replacement as needed. We also provide a once a year annual meeting and potluck picnic for all. *These expenses add up to several thousand dollars, that is why we need all neighbors to pay the association fee so we may keep our costs low and our property values high.* We look forward to seeing you all at the beach!

Meeting and Picnic

As a reminder, the dues will cover burgers, hot dogs, buns, soft drinks, and condiments. The Picnic Committee will do a headcount and provide further information closer to the actual date. So put a “SAVE THE DATE” in/on your calendar.

Kayak storage rental

Kayak storage rental is from May 15th through November 1st. This year we are foregoing the deposit fee to simplify the process, thus the fee for a kayak will be \$50 for the season. We still ask that your kayak be removed at the end of the season. We ask that kayaks are returned to the racks when not in use and kayaks be removed by November 1st. No winter storage available. There are 21 spaces for kayaks. **If you are interested in kayak space, please complete the attached form and return with your payment by May 10th. If there is**
