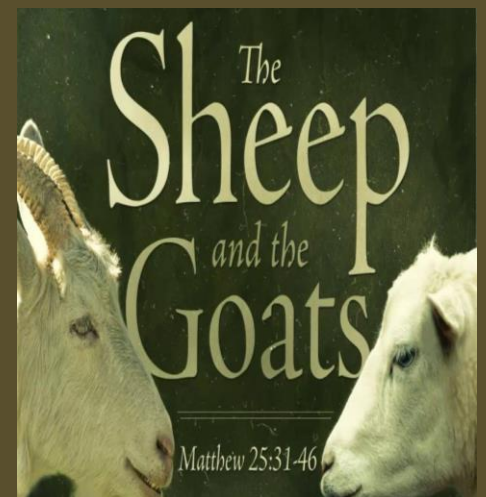

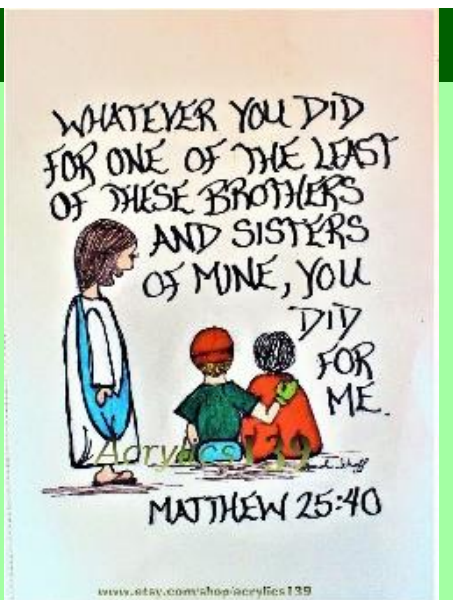
Support Your Parish:

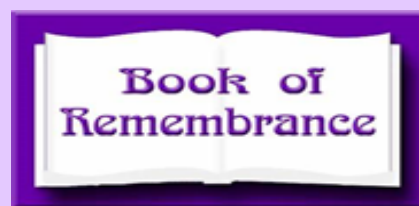
