DESCRIPTION: It is very rare to find a 1970's York Crest with a spotted Zebrawood riser. This is the shorter 60" hunting model. This bow is in excellent condition for its age. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. Note: The upper tip overlay was missing, so it was duplicated as best I could—see pics for slight differences (see pics on p. 3). Two barely visible professionally filled sight screw holes on the face of the riser (see far right pic on p. 4). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; some minor discoloration of a 5 inch section of the upper limb glass (looks a bit like water spots—see pic on last page); A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are faint but fully intact. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
