REQUIRED TRAINING

FOR PREVENTION OF SEXUAL MISCONDUCT SUNDAY, JUNE 25

<u>All</u> UPCR employees and volunteer workers are required to participate in a training session for the prevention of sexual misconduct. The aim of the training is to help ensure that our church is a safe place and that all employees and volunteer workers understand their responsibilities in preventing sexual misconduct. The training will be held after worship on Sunday, June 25. The concise training session will last approximately 25 to 30 minutes and will be followed by a luncheon for participants.

All employees and volunteer workers will be required to sign a form verifying that they have attended the training, have received the training materials and agree to abide by UPCR's policy and procedures related to the prevention of sexual misconduct. The signed forms will be kept on file in the office.

Ask a Session member if you have questions about this topic. A make-up training session will be scheduled if needed to accommodate anyone who did not attend the June 25 session.
