THE MONTH OF MAY...

...IDENTITY: MY LIFE OF FAITH... Who Am I

Most of us struggle with our identity at some point in life. Not knowing who you are can really mess up where you are. I know! When I was in my early twenties, I was a passenger in life traveling without a destination. I had grown up in a great environment, but I had made a total mess of my life. Jesus changed all that; He changed me, and now my identity is wrapped up in Christ. In these six sessions, we will see what God says about who we are and who we can be in Christ.
