





The Chevy Corvette Makes "Car and Driver's 10 Best"



In a world where social media holds such sway over public opinion, its easy to lose sight of the "gold standards" that the automotive community has used to identify what's great in the current marketplace. However, when a publication as respected as "Car and Driver" publishes its "10 Best" lists, the world takes notice. Maybe its because publications like Car and Driver have always afforded an objective, seemingly unbiased opinion on the cars we love...and love to hate. But more than that, Car and Driver's unique perspective of putting the reader "in the driver's seat" affords us all an opportunity to experience many cars thru the written word. Whatever makes it good, seeing the new Corvette (in all its current iterations) landed among the best wasn't just good...it was freaking awesome! (Hey, I never claimed we were an unbiased source of Corvette news – afterall, we are CORVSPORT.com – the ULTIMATE CORVETTE DATABASE!)

What Is An L88 Engine?

The L88 engine was GM's high-performance, race-bred 427 big-block offering for 1967. Think of it as an iron-block version of the legendary aluminum ZL1 mill. Zora Arkus-Duntov knew that winning races would sell Corvettes, but GM was busy trying to comply with a 1957 ban on factory racing. Duntov wasn't having any of that nonsense and kept slipping race-ready Corvettes into the lineup using numerous specialty RPO codes. GM was already producing the 427 big-block in the form of the L32 (390 hp) and the L72(425 hp) for the 1967 Corvette, but Duntov wanted more—way more.

Record-Breaking C8 Corvette Goes 8.64

Now three years into production, the <u>C8 Corvette</u> is an increasingly popular platform with racers, enthusiasts, and aftermarket performance companies, all modifying the platform and achieving new feats of performance with it. Extreme Turbo Systems (ETS) recently claimed the quarter-mile, elapsed time, and speed records with its Torch Red, twin-turbo C8, clocking an 8.644-second and 170.71-mph run.

The car setting the pace for modified C8s everywhere is a 2020 Corvette that belongs to Extreme Turbo Systems of Vancouver, Washington, and is driven by Zack Morgan, race team manager for ETS.



"It's had the turbo system pretty much since it was new," explained Morgan. "It's the same car that was the first to the 9s and first over 1,000 horsepower. It's a development car for our components for the C8 platform."Extreme Turbo Systems lowers the C8 Corvette drag racing record using 1,385 rear-wheel hp.

Why Has 2024 Z06 Production Been So Erratic?



In the chart below, provided by our dedicated enthusiast Roger Kiel, you'll notice a complete void in production from 1/04/2024 to 1/09/2024, with a total of 7 days this year when **NO** 2024 Z06s were produced. The average for 2024 is only **THREE** Z06s a day. For comparison, the Bowling Green Assembly Plant has been averaging approximately **31** Z06s per production day before this erratic production, and there have been numerous days where 60+ Z06s rolled off the line.


