ORDINANCE NO. 2018-19

A BILL

FOR AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA,
COLORADO AMENDING SECTION 134-358, BY ADDING SUBSECTION (c)
OF THE CITY CODE PERTAINING TO PARKING PROHIBITION
FOR MOTOR HOMES AND CAMPER TRAILERS

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora, Colorado (the "City"), is a home rule municipality organized pursuant to Article XX of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, as a home rule municipality, the City has broad authority to exercise its police power to promote and protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted in Article VIII of the City code, Special Local Restrictions, concerning parking violations in the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 134-358 prohibits parking a motor home or camper trailer on a right-of-way in excess of five (5) days; and

WHEREAS, some individuals have avoided ticketing and prosecution under this law by moving their motor homes or trailers each five days to another portion of the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the law is to avoid long-term motor home or camper trailer parking on the public right-of-way, which intent is not met when individuals simply move their motor home or camper trailer a different location on the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to clarify City Code Section 134-358, by amending to add a requirement for complete removal of a motor home or camper trailer from the public right-of-way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 134-358 of the City Code of the City of Aurora, Colorado, is hereby amended to add subsection (c) as follows:


(c) It shall not be a defense to this Section that the motor home or camper trailer has been moved to a different location within the public right-of-way. To be in compliance, the motor home or camper trailer must be removed from the public right-of-way for 72 hours.

Section 2. That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, of the City Code of the City of Aurora, Colorado, in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

Section 3. That, pursuant to Section 5-5 of the Charter of the City of Aurora, Colorado, the second publication of this ordinance shall be by reference, utilizing the ordinance title.


