## **Film Requirements**

The film may be of just about any genre (drama, comedy, documentary, science fiction, horror, etc.), but it should be an original, scripted work. We will not consider recordings of live performances or home videos. The film should also meet these criteria:

- The length of the film must be between 5 and 20 minutes.
- It should be an original work written by one or more members of the submitting team.
- The content should be of sufficient good taste that it would meet PG-13 standards and be suitable for public display. The judging panel maintains all rights to exclude a film from consideration that, in its judgement, does not meet this requirement or to cut out objectionable material.
- It must be produced in the year leading up to the festival, with filming ending August 1, 2019 or after.
- Be careful not to utilize any music, film, or words that would be subject to copyright protection.
- Yes, you may record your work on a phone, but please record all scenes in landscape orientation.

#### Awards

Films will be evaluated and ranked individually by a panel of judges. Given that films will be submitted in a variety of genres, each judge will rank films looking at the overall value of each film, taking into consideration characteristics pertinent to each film's genre, rather than using a standardized score sheet. Individual judge rankings will be compiled to determine overall rankings.

The top 8 films (more if time allows), as ranked by the judging panel, will be played at the Dwight Harvest Days Short Film Festival at the Harvest Days Outdoor Theater in Downtown Dwight on Friday, September 18, 2020. The first place winner will receive a trophy, and the second through eighth place winners will receive medals.
