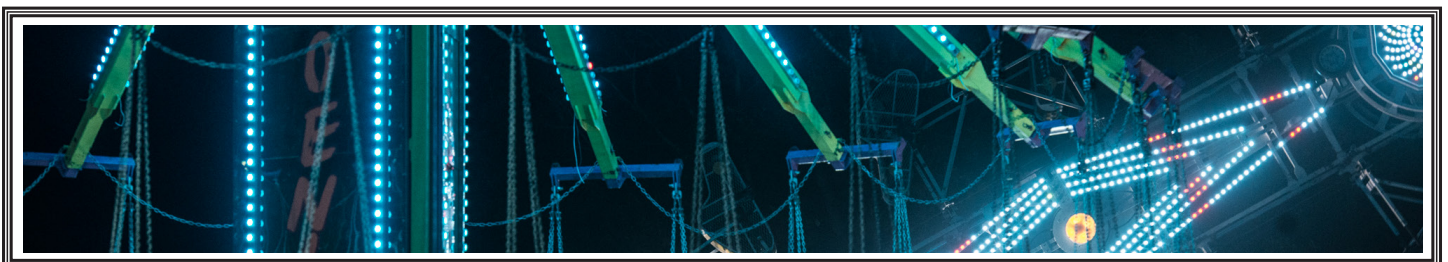
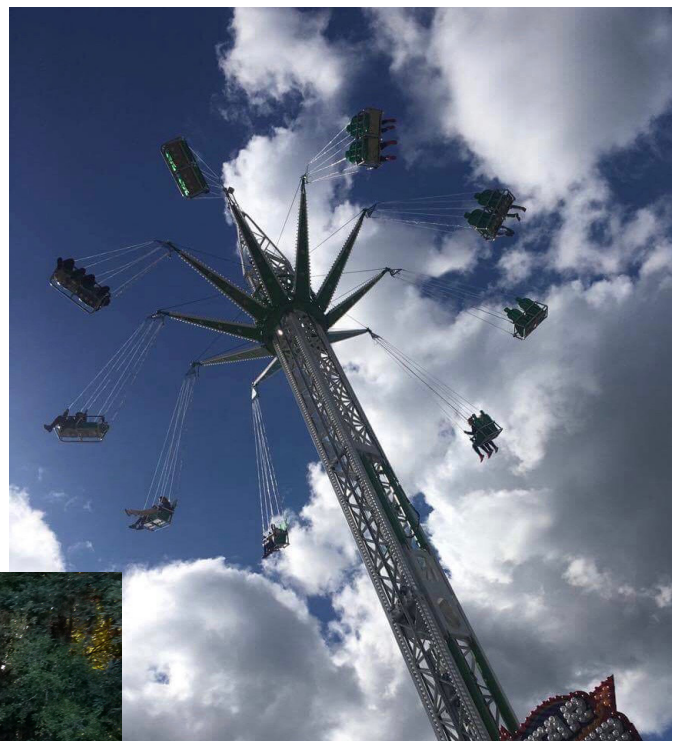
After a much longer absence than anticipated the Fair Buzz is back!

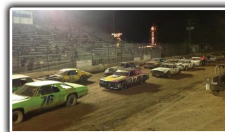

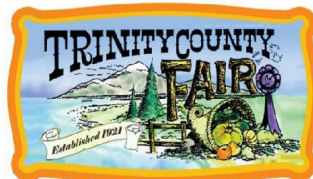

Here are the recently approved rules and regulation in place for the Fair:

TRINITY COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS AND EVENT CENTER

RULES AND REGULATIONS: (FOR THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC, EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS)

1. ITEMS PROHIBITED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS, PARKING LOTS AND CAMPSITES INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:
 - a. CONTRABAND, ILLEGAL NARCOTICS, FIREARMS, KNIVES (Fixed Blade 3” or Longer), TOXIC/HAZARDOUS LIQUIDS, CHEMICALS OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE THAT MAY BE HARMFUL TO HUMANS AND ANIMALS.
 - b. CONCEALED FIREARMS ARE PROHIBITED ON COUNTY OF TRINITY PROPERTY (Trinity County Municipal Code – Chapter 9.32 (Weapons), 9.32.00 (Prohibition) – (Ord. 1066 §1 (part), 1985).
2. NO GLASS CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND.
3. NO OPEN BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.
 - a. ALL FLUIDS IN OPEN, UNSEALED CONTAINERS MUST BE DUMPED OR TAKEN BACK TO YOUR VEHICLE.
 - b. IF CONTENTS OF OPEN CONTAINERS ARE DUMPED, COMPLIMENTARY SEALED BOTTLED WATER WILL BE PROVIDED UPON REQUEST.
4. NO ALCOHOL OR ILLEGAL DRUGS.
5. NO ANIMALS EXCEPT SERVICE ANIMALS THAT ARE TRAINED TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO HANDICAPPED PERSONS.
6. NO ICE CHESTS.
7. ALL BACKPACKS, FANNY PACKS, BAGS, PURSES, ETC. WILL BE SEARCHED PRIOR TO ENTRY TO THE FAIRGROUNDS.
8. NO SMOKING EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS: PARKING LOTS, CAMPGROUNDS, PIT AREAS, DESIGNATED BEER GARDEN AND RACEWAY ALCOHOL SERVING AREA AND ANY OTHER AREA AS DEFINED BY THE CEO/FAIR MANAGER.
9. *NO FROWNS, FAIR IS FUN!*
