- 1. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance.
- 2. All trophies to be held for one year only and to be returned CLEAN 14 days before the 2023 show.
- 3. Cars requiring to park in the wagon park will be charged £15, car park £10
- 4. ENTRIES CLOSE post-dated 13th May 2023. Entries after 13th May double fee. STRICTLY NO ENTRIES TAKEN AFTER 20th MAY 2023 AND NO ENTRIES TAKEN ON THE DAY.
- 5. If the show re-schedules its show date (usually due to adverse weather conditions) the entry fee will be refunded less an administration cost of 25%, the secretary must have a request of refund BEFORE the new show date, under no circumstances will a refund be given after the new show date. If the show is completely abandoned, refunds will only be given upon receipt of an SAE addressed to the secretary, the entry fee will be refunded less an administration cost of 25%. SAE must be received within 28 days of the cancellation.
- 6. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
- Entry fee WILL NOT be refunded if the horses, owners or riders are not correctly registered with the relevant societies before the show day.
- 8. All prize money, prizes and cups to be collected on the show days, nothing to be sent out after the show days.
- CHAMPION OR RESERVE CHAMPION PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE GIVEN OUT UNTIL AFTER THE SUPREMES. To be collected from secretary's tent on the day of the show.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- 11. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes.
- 12. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for accidents or damage to riders, competitors, spectators, owners or animals or any other property.
- 13. The decision of the judge is final.
- 14. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not. Please see B.S.P.S. Rule 43 regarding all B.S.P.S. classes
- 15. Any objection or protest must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by a fee of £50 which may be forfeited to the show funds in the event of an objection been over ruled
- 16. No litter is to be left on the showground. CLEANING OUT OF HORSEBOXES AND TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN
- 17. No nomination or substitute entries will be accepted.
- 18. Under no circumstances is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.
- 19. All grooms entering the ring must be correctly dressed and must wear a hat in the ring.
- 20. Entry fees will only be returned (minus 25%) with a valid vet's or doctor's certificate BEFORE show day
- 21. Prize money: For all Ridden and In-hand classes prize money will be awarded as follows. Three entries or less 1st prize only, four or five entries 1st and 2nd Prize and 6 or more entries as per schedule.
- 22. RULES FOR RIDDEN SPORTS HORSE AFFILIATED CLASSES. It is strongly recommended that competitors aged 18 or over wear Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current Safety Standards: All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/ NZS 3838 2003 onwards. It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear such skull caps or hats. In the jumping phase of working hunter classes the aforementioned skull caps/riding hats must be worn. No earrings to be worn when competing in the Sports Horse GB affiliated classes, and horses must be shod on all four hooves.
- 23. All horses and ponies entering the Showground **must be vaccinated**, and vaccination certificates / passports must accompany the horse or pony to the Show and be available for checking. Un-vaccinated horses, or those exhibitors unable to produce a passport on request will be prevented from competing and will be asked to leave the showground. Entry fees will not be refunded.

This show is a qualifier for the UK Ponies & Horses Summer Championships.. 1st 2nd and 3rd placed horses in Classes 212 to 214 will qualify for the Gold Medal Classes at the Spring Classic to take place in March at Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre, Equifest 2023 & BSPA Finals 2023. Competitors are not required to become a member of UK Ponies & Horses to compete in the Summer Classic. Qualification cards are not issued on the day, however results can be verified by the office.

Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:

- (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity.
- (ii) Receive remuneration for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or Riding School (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- (iii) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
- (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador or Supported Person, in any showing classes, UK Ponies and Horses or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, UK Ponies and Horses or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working Show Horse and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the previous year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show.

The above Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and only ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership.

No person included on any affiliated Judging Panel can compete in a UK Ponies and Horses Amateur Class. UK Ponies and Horses feel that this is not entering into the spirit of the competition.






