What a great presentation and update last Sunday about our **October Tithing Recipient** from Tithing Liaison, Dick Smith. Petals started in 2001 with only 25 students but it has grown to 256 students! The main objective for the School is to provide a well-rounded education to Kenyan youth based on excellent academic programs, teaching staff and facilities. Academically, they have consistently remained at the top of the schools in the district. The cost annually per student amounts to \$580 which includes tuition, boarding and uniforms. An anonymous member has donated \$1,000 towards a Matching Grant. Orange County Jail Fruitage

An Excerpt from a Report by George Birdsong, Chaplain for Men's Jail

Another man requested a visit by message slip in late June was in custody and said he and his wife loved CS. Our literature committee began sending him Bible lessons. He had an amazing story to share. I will refer to him as Jason. I often begin with the Bible and share Psalms 23 and 91 with new contacts. Also like to read testimonies from the book HEALING SPIRITUALLY. I selected a testimony of a man who had been shot several times by the police during a bank robbery. As he was being carried into the emergency room, he saw the words Christian Science in thought . . .from a CS Sentinel that had been on his mother's coffee table when he was growing up. In the testimony, the man had a remarkable healing saying that if he came out alive, he would look into Christian Science. Jason said that he had a similar experience having been shot in the head and in a coma for 2 months, yet surviving. We had several heartfelt visits, sharing the truths of Christian Science. Jason is a musician and producer and recently signed a contract to go on a world tour beginning in Australia on October 22. He loves the message of the YOU ARE LOVED PROJECT and would like to spread this message worldwide. Alex Cook has his contact information. Jason was released this past Thursday.
