Elsie M. Indo, 81, resident of Ferndale and former resident of Grindstone City, died at the Hilton nursing Home in Ferndale on Wednesday, May 19, 2004, after a long illness. Mrs. Indo was born October 29, 1922 in Youngstown, Ohio, daughter of the late Mary (Spam) Rothe. Miss Elsie Rothe and Alvin J. Indo were united in marriage at St. Michael's Catholic Church Rectory, Port Austin, on February 15, 1941. They celebrated 60 years of marriage before Alvin's death in 2001.
