B – Cemetery survey – A separate survey was done by Mediema VanKlooten (Grand Rapids) for the neighbor that indicates Tingley's survey is erroneous. We will obtain a copy of the VanKlooten survey and written consent to follow the VanKlooten survey by the land owner.

C – MCC-meeting (weed control) – When we do our Lake weed control, we have to have the company come to a Board meeting and have a contract signed **by the Board** during our meeting – **Not the Lake Associations**

D – Park playground – Sidney State Bank is discussing donations for new equipment at the park. We are also looking at other donation sources in the community.

NEW BUSINESS:

B – Cemetery plowing – Unauthorized Plowing. It is proposed that we put up gates at the entrances for off-season with no burials during winter. Welder motions to investigate the cost. Stover seconds. All in favor. Carried.

D – Fire Barn – We will not pay for the roof repair at the Stanton Fire Barn.
