

Defender of the Needy PSALM 72:12-14





Ancient Home Synagogue

The term "synagogue" refers generally to a Jewish assembly for prayer. During the first-century AD, the term referred primarily to buildings designed to house such assemblies. Jews living in Greek towns usually assembled for prayer in private homes—and it an assembly member was weathy, the synagogue might have been held in a home like this one.




