

An Update on Our Return to In-Person Ministry

Suspension of Live Worship Continues

The Church Board decided at the May 7th meeting to align our re-opening decisions with the Badger Bounce Back plan guided by the Wisconsin Department of Health. This plan provides for a gradual, three-phased approach to reopening.

The Board will continue to suspend in-person ministry through the completion of Phase One of the program, and we will reassess possibilities for a return as we approach Phase Two.

Reaching Phase One requires a two-week decline of cases of COVID-19 followed by a continued period of social-distancing and suspension of live worship.

Phase Two may allow for smaller gatherings with many social-distancing adjustments to our practices. We do not anticipate reaching Phase Two until mid to late June at the very earliest. The timeline for returning to our regular worship and ministry schedule will be determined by the decline of the virus.

We can not offer a calendar date at this time.

But we will keep you all informed of our progress through all our regular methods of communication. In the meantime, we will continue to develop engaging on-line worship opportunities and explore creative ways to gather when it is safe and appropriate. Please stay tuned....
