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Official Minutes of November 11, 2014 General Meeting

1. Motion to approve the proposed 2015 Budget made by Ted Wolford and seconded by John Veninga. All approve, none oppose.
2. Homeowners report cars for sale in right of way at SW 62 Ave. Rd. and SW 103 St. Rd. KCPOA to ask Marion County if they can post a sign there as a deterrent.
3. Homeowners ask how much money is in the KCPOA MSBU account. KCPOA to contact Pete Hodges, Marion County, and request a complete financial accounting of funds collected and spent since the inception of the program.
4. Homeowners report the striping of SW 115 St. Rd. has not slowed down traffic. Mr. Mais contemplating getting a petition signed by homeowners in affected area and presenting it to Marion County requesting other measures implemented to reduce traffic speed.
5. Homeowners report speeding by Florida Environmental Express garbage trucks in the subdivision. KCPOA to write a letter after getting truck numbers.
6. Katica Pavicic requested the Board of Directors share 50% of the cost of lighting in the Marco Polo Village II HOA. The Board of Directors will put the request on its next Board of Directors meeting agenda.
