## January Block of the Month: Friendship Star

Block finishes at 12" (unfinished at 12 1/2").
Materials:
From dark fabric cut:
1-4 1/2" square
2-5" squares
From light fabric cut:
4-41/2" squares
2-5" squares
Construction:
Draw a diagonal line on the back of each light fabric $5^{\prime \prime}$ square. Matching light and dark 5 " squares right sides together, sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on either side of line. Cut apart on drawn line and press open. Trim squares to form $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ half-square triangle (HST) units.

Sew together the squares and HSTs as shown in diagram. Press and measure finished block. It should be 12 1/2" square.
***Remember your 1/4" seam allowance.***

You can choose to make a complete quilt top by repeating these instructions or you can set this block aside and make a sampler quilt. We look forward to seeing everyone's blocks.
