Gobble, Gobble, Gobble....but Move Your Feet Before You Eat along with about 10,000 new and old friends.

It's time for the Oceanside Turkey Trot again on Thanksgiving Day, Nov 24th. Named one of the country's top trots by Runner's World magazine, the Oceanside Turkey Trot draws trotters county-wide and even from other countries.

You can run, walk or trot the 5K, or 5 miles or for young trotters (12 and younger) a 1/5 mile trot. For seniors (between 65 and 100) there is the Senior 5K or 5 Mile, NO SENIOR MILE this year. Participants are scored by age range so seniors are not competing against 20 year old grandchildren.

Everyone who registers receives a t-shirt, swag bag and medal...for all finishers. You can also be a virtual runner with the same prizes. Go online to: Oceanside Turkey Trot to pay race fee and sign an injury waiver. Race fees vary according to what event runners participate and a portion of each entry fee may be designated to the non-profit of your choice.
