

**M:** In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.




#### CONFESSION OF SINS

#### FIRST LESSON

1 Kings 19:3-8 (NIV)

<sup>3</sup> Elijah was afraid and ran for his life. When he came to Beersheba in Judah, he left his servant there, <sup>4</sup> while he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness. He came to a broom bush, sat down under it and prayed that he might die. "I have had enough, LORD," he said. "Take my life; I am no better than my ancestors." <sup>5</sup> Then he lay down under the bush and fell asleep.

All at once an angel touched him and said, "Get up and eat." <sup>6</sup> He looked around, and there by his head was some bread baked over hot coals, and a jar of water. He ate and drank and then lay down again.

<sup>7</sup> The angel of the LORD came back a second time and touched him and said, "Get up and eat, for the journey is too much for you." <sup>8</sup> So he got up and ate and drank. Strengthened by that food, he traveled forty days and forty nights until he reached Horeb, the mountain of God.

#### SECOND LESSON

**Ephesians 4:30-5:2 (EHV)** 

<sup>30</sup> Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. <sup>31</sup> Get rid of every kind of bitterness, rage, anger, quarreling, and slander, along with every kind of malice. <sup>32</sup> Instead, be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God in Christ has forgiven us.

Therefore, be imitators of God as his dearly loved children. <sup>2</sup> And walk in love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself for us, as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

<sup>41</sup> So the Jews started grumbling about him, because he said, "I am the bread that came down from heaven." <sup>42</sup> They asked, "Isn't this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? So how can he say, 'I have come down from heaven'?"

<sup>43</sup> Jesus answered them, "Stop grumbling among yourselves. <sup>44</sup> No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the Last Day. <sup>45</sup> It is written in the Prophets, 'They will all be taught by God.' Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me. <sup>46</sup> I am not saying that anyone has seen the Father except the one who is from God. He is the one who has seen the Father. <sup>47</sup> Amen, Amen, I tell you: The one who believes in me has eternal life.

<sup>48</sup> "I am the Bread of Life. <sup>49</sup> Your fathers ate manna in the wilderness, and they died. <sup>50</sup> This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that anyone may eat it and not die. <sup>51</sup> I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats this bread, he will live forever. The bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."



#### NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation, he came down from heaven, was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary, and became fully human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate. He suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who in unity with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.



#### **PREFACE**


**M:** The Lord be with you.


