

# Tailored Shirt Class

## Required items:

- Notepaper/pen
- A tailored shirt pattern (or selection of 2 or 3 patterns) with some shaping. Patterns with princess seams (instead of darts) will be more homework-intensive because of the additional pattern pieces. Commercial patterns or patterns drafted from the Moulage are fine. Instructor has final pattern selection authority.
- 2 to 2 ½ yards of fashion fabric appropriate for making a dress shirt (crisp, firm fabrics such as cotton or linen broadcloth or pique, or silks like duppioni or taffeta). Pre-wash and dry your fabric in the manner you will launder it once it's a garment.
- Matching high-quality polyester thread
- A bit of high-quality, light to mid-weight, fusible interfacing (available for purchase during class if you're unsure what to get)
- Buttons or other closure

## Provided items:

- ✓ Pattern paper
- ✓ Muslin

The following items are not required, as the sewing classroom is well-equipped, but you may choose to have your own:

- Small see-through ruler (approx 2"x 18" and flexible)
- Scissors and/or rotary cutter
- Glass or metal head Pins & Pin cushion
- Seam ripper
- Hand sewing needles
- Bees' wax or Thread Heaven
- Tape Measure
- Thread clippers
- Magnifier glasses
- Supply bin/tote
- Hem gauge
- Tailor's chalk or other marking tool(s)
- Sewing machine
- Colored pencils (2 or 3)
- Drafting (or just regular school/office) pencil
