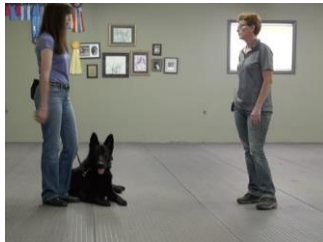


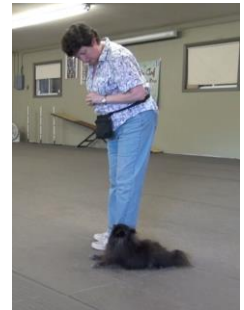


Get Connected with your Dog I

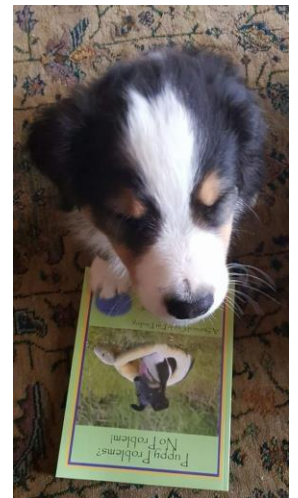
Brenda equips dog trainers with the skill sets to improve their training results. To achieve this, she blends learning theory, how to use a dog's body language during the training process with a study of dog behavior. You will learn the protocols and exercises she has developed over



decades of successful dog training and instructing others on how to train dogs. Teaching emphasis is on watching "intention behaviors" and using them to predict what will happen next. Brenda Aloff teaches trainers to better understand the dog's body language to enhance communication.



"Understanding dog behavior is more about how the dog learns – and what the animal hears – than what we are saying. And it involves the pet and the owner working collaboratively. It's teaching the clients to train their animal – training the people to train the dogs... and getting them to understand how the dog communicates" - Brenda Aloff



Learn:

- To read dog's' body language in order to understand what they are saying
- Dogs are looking for "body language" not verbal language. What does that mean in training terms?
- To be consistent and coherent in your interactions with your dog.



- What are space Games and why should we care?
- Not just Attention – an **Emotional Anchor**. Create attention that is more than your dog just "looking at you". Instead, the sort of attention that actually binds the dog to you, preventing the environment from stealing your performance
- What role does **Impulse Control** play in your interactions with your dog and how does it make or break performance?
- Learn Brenda's Get Connected system that teaches impulse control, so it is a decision making process taught to the dog to include you, rather than following their instinct
