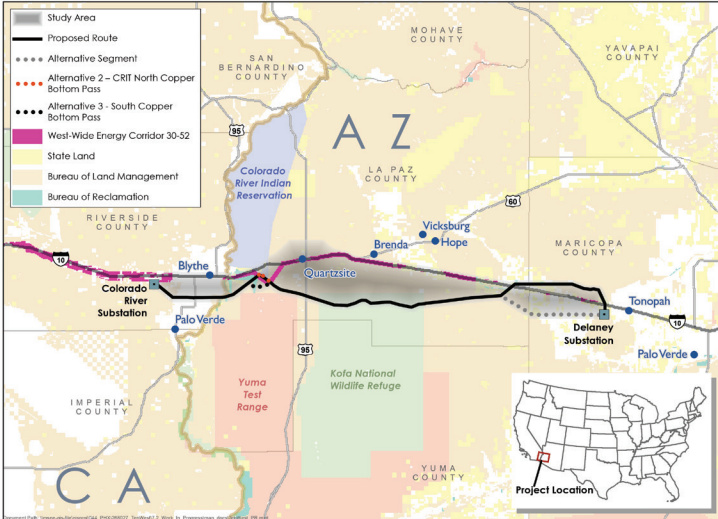




Ten West Link Transmission Project

The Ten West Link Transmission Project is a proposed electrical interconnection that would transmit reliable, economic and environmentally friendly electric energy between Southeast California and Southwest Arizona, bringing electric system benefits to the Desert Southwest – one of America’s fastest growing regions.

The Project would provide a reliable 500 kV transmission connection between substations in Tonopah, Arizona and Riverside County, California, west of the City of Blythe. The proposed 114 mile route, with 97 miles in Arizona and 17 miles in California, would minimize land and resource impacts by largely following an existing transmission line in an established utility corridor.

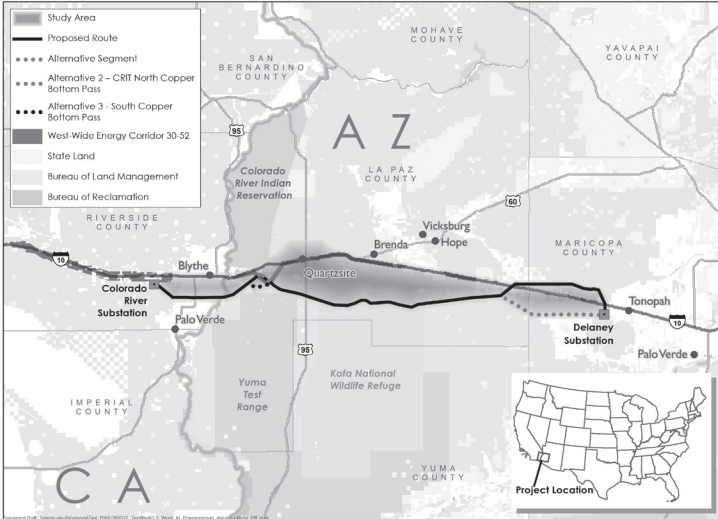
