Now, there are many auto experts on the internet naming their list of the best and worst used vehicles you should buy. It's fairly easy to recommend Toyota products as best in class for reliability and probably my 1999 Land Rover Discovery at or near the bottom of the list.

Let's approach this question a different way. Ask your self what year might have been the worst overall for car makers attempts on reliability. I say it was 2008 during the last great recession. Manufactures cut corners wherever possible to stay afloat. I offer my experience with this year's offerings. I own a top of the line luxury diesel motor home built on a leftover 2006 chassis with a smaller engine than was advertised in their brochure.
