Total Runs limited to 350 Saturday & Sunday. Entry limit on Friday 175.

This is a one-ring agility trial, held indoors on permanent mats.

Ring size is 100' x 90'. Electronic timers will be used.

ALL BREEDS AND MIXED BREEDS MAY COMPETE.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries are offered all 3 days. Dogs must be 15 months of age.

NO ASCA NUMBER REQUIRED UNLESS YOU WANT TO EARN ASCA TITLES. (see ASCA Service Membership and QT number application in premium.)

Interested in the <u>Agility Competition Enthusiast (ACE) program?</u>

The new ASCA ACE and ACE senior program will be offered at these trials. ASCA recently added a lower jump height program. Dogs entered in the ACE program will also have an additional 10% in course time. Any age dog can jump 4" lower than its standard jump height (i.e. a dog measuring 20" at the withers can enter the 16" ACE standard division classes) and compete for titles.

Dogs with a wither height of 11" & under can jump 4"; Dogs with a wither height >11" and <14" can jump 8"; Dogs with a with height of >14" and <18" can jump 12" and Dogs with a wither height over 18" can jump 16". Points from the two programs cannot be transferred or combined; except for certain Elite Q's earned in the Champion program. A dog can only enter either the ACE program OR the Championship program each day. See the ASCA web site for more details. http://www.asca.org

ASCA allows training in the ring and the judge will explain at briefing. Toys will be allowed in the ring for training purposes.

These toys may not involve food or treats of any kind, may not make noise, or may not leave parts behind. All handlers declaring toys will mark the gate sheet with a "T" at the run checkin and will run at the end of the class in order by jump height. Upon entering the ring, handlers must declare to the judge that they have a toy. They will be immediately eliminated whether or not the toy is used and will have the specified time for training in the ring. If handlers bring a toy in the ring without declaring it, they will be asked to leave immediately.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This event is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America, hereinafter referred to as "ASCA". This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. For a complete listing of the rules, visit http://www.asca.org

TNASC, its board of directors, ASCA, and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, owners or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

Through submission of entry, the competitor acknowledges that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, including, but not limited to the following:

- 1. All ASCA Agility trials shall be open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- 2. All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA Agility Trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- 3. Any dog, which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the Agility trial. Any dog, which the judge feels is not in control, will be excused from the Agility trial.
- 4. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial, will be reported to ASCA and may be banned from further TNASC events.
- 5. No leads, collars, food, toys, etc. will be allowed on the course.
- 6. No pinch or prong collars are allowed on the trial grounds
- 7. All dogs must be on lead or securely crated when not in the ring. No unattended X-pens!
- 8. The organizing committee of this event reserves the right to refuse any entry based on suitable causes only. Anyone who is not in good standing with TNASC or ASCA will not be allowed entry.
- 9. Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks are not permitted on the trial grounds RELEASE:
- 1. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves, their guests and the actions of their dogs.
- 2. All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only but may not videotape any portion of this event for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of ASCA.
- 3. Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS AND HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT TO ASCA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cable cast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known. All competitors and handlers hereby release ASCA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claims or cause of action for invasion of rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

BEHAVIOR:

- 1. Competitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any competitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site. No refund will be made.
- 2. Handlers caught not picking up after their dog may be asked to leave the show site and no refund will be made.

OBSTACLES:

The following obstacles may be used at this agility trial: Weave Poles (24" spread), Nonwinged single hurdle(s), 36' Dog walk (slatted, rubber surface), Tire Jump Displaceable (24" inner center), Winged single hurdles, A-frame (5'6" at the apex, slatted, rubber surface), Teeter-totter (rubberized, no slats), Double bar hurdle, Open tunnels **ENTRIES:**

Pre-Trial Entries open October 16, 2019 and must be received no later than 6:00 pm November 13, 2019 after which time no pre-trial entries will be accepted or cancelled. Dogs receiving titles after the closing date may move-up by providing the trial secretary with: the owner's full name, dog's name, ASCA (or other) number, class entered and from and to level. Day to day move ups are allowed. Confirmations will be emailed unless you request otherwise. Please double-check your confirmation. There will be no changes the day of the trial. There will be a \$40 fee if your check is returned.

Day-of entries accepted up until 30 minutes before each trial starts if entry limits have not been met or at trial secretary's discretion.

CHECK IN AND MEASUREMENT:

Check-in, Day of Entry and official measurements for Friday's trial will be from 6:30 - 6:45 pm. Walk-thru starts at 6:45 pm. Judging begins at 7:00 pm.

Check-in, Day of Entry and official measurements for Saturday will be 8:15 - 8:45am walk-thru at 8:45am and Sunday will be from 7:15 - 7:45 am. Walk-thru starts at 7:45 am. Judging begins at 8:00 am. AWARDS:

All qualifiers will receive qualifying ribbons as well as placement ribbons for 1st - 4th by jump height. Rosette and Commemorative Bar will be awarded for each team completing an ATCH. Please inform Awards Chairman of possibility prior to running! HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS:

On Friday a HIT will be awarded. On Saturday & Sunday awards are as follows: HIT Novice, Open and Elite (eligible dogs must be entered in the same level all classes), Veteran Dog & Junior. Overall awards for HIT Aussie & HIT non-Aussie will also be presented (eligible dogs do not have to be entered in same level all classes). A HIT ACE Overall rosette will be awarded each day.

*High in Trial qualifying points are dependent on class level of qualifying scores earned. Faultless qualifying runs in each class are given the following HIT Q point values:

Elite regular = 10 points. Elite jumpers and gamblers = 7 points.

Open regular = 9 points. Open jumpers and gamblers = 6 points.

Novice regular = 8 points. Novice jumpers and gamblers = 5 points. A faulted (.01 to 5 faults) qualifying run HIT Q points: Elite 5 pts, Open 4.5 pts, Novice 4 pts.

In the event of a tie, the highest total of the YPS from all regular qualifying runs in will be the highest running the winter of a running the running

determine the winner. The 2nd tie breaker will be the highest number of gambler points earned in qualifying rounds. In the event a 3rd tie breaker is needed it will be the dog with the highest total of YPS from all qualifying jumper rounds.

All ribbons, rosettes, and prizes must be picked up by end of day Sunday. None will be mailed. All unclaimed ribbons, rosettes, and prizes remain the property of the awarding club.

ASCA Service Membership and QT Number Application

In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QT Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the QT number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, Service, is required). ASCA membership does not have to be maintained in subsequent years.

It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA points earned when applying for a QT Number.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a QTnumber to compete?

- You do not need a QT number in order to compete in Agility or Stock, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You will need a QT number to enter an Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, or Tracking Test.
- Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a QT number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

If you would like your dog's points recorded by ASCA, and receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you will need to obtain a QT number.

What is the total cost for a QT number?

In order to obtain a QT number for your dog, you must be a member. The cost for a basic Service Membership is \$10 per **owner** if not already a current member.

 Your membership is good for one year and does not need to be renewed unless you want to obtain another QT number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of \$10 per dog.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be \$20. For two dogs, the cost would be \$30, etc.
