## Join SustainableEHC

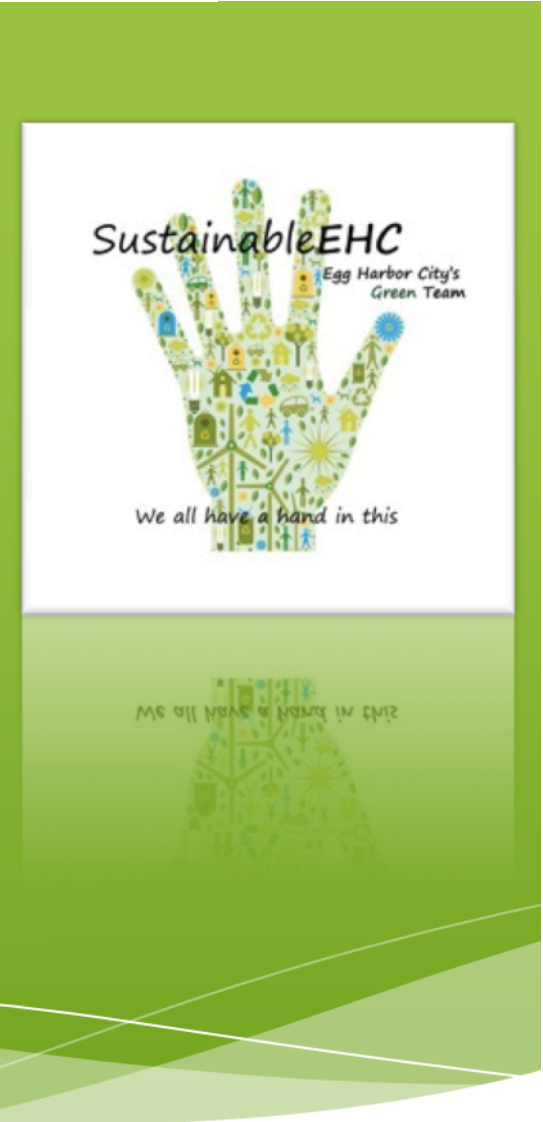
SustainableEHC meets monthly at Egg Harbor City Hall to discuss plans and goals and develop programs that protect our fragile environment.
