

## STEPS & TRADITIONS

## THE TWELVE STEPS OF NA

- 1 We admitted we were powerless over our addiction. That our lives had become unmanageable.
- 2 We came to believe that a power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
- 3 We made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God ***as we understood him.***
- 4 We made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
- 5 We admitted to God, to ourselves and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.
- 6 We were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.
- 7 We humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings.
- 8 We made a list of all persons we had harmed and became willing to make amends to them all.
- 9 We made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
- 10 We continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.
- 11 We sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God ***as we understood Him,*** praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.
- 12 Having had a spiritual awakening as a result of these steps, we tried to carry this message to Addicts and practice these principles in all our affairs.

## THE TWELVE TRADITIONS OF N.A.

- 1 Our common welfare should come first: personal recovery depends on N.A. unity.
- 2 For our group purpose there is but one ultimate authority, a loving God as He may express Himself in our group conscience. Our leaders are but trusted servants, they do not govern.
- 3 The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop using.
- 4 Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or N.A. as a whole.
- 5 Each group has but one primary purpose—to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.
- 6 An N.A. Group ought never endorse, finance, or lend the N.A. name to any related facility or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property or prestige divert us from our primary purpose.
- 7 Every N.A. Group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.
- 8 Narcotics Anonymous should remain forever non-professional, but our service centers may employ special workers.
- 9 N.A. as such, ought never be organized, but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.
- 10 Narcotics Anonymous has no opinion on outside issues, hence the N.A. name ought never be drawn into public controversy.
- 11 Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio, and films.
- 12 Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our Traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities.
