Adopt Spay/Neuter



PAWS is a 501(c)3 non-profit, no-kill animal shelter existing on the generosity of private donors.



P.A.W.S. was contacted by law enforcement when nine dogs were found left in what appeared to be an abandoned mobile home in extreme heat with no air, no food, and no water. You could see the dogs gasping for air behind the closed windows. It was very evident that these animals had went days without food or water. Time was of the essence, as many of these dogs would not have made it another 24 hours.

With the help of two SCSD deputies, P.A.W.S. was able to rescue all nine dogs that day. These dogs were severely dehydrated, malnourished, emaciated, and infested with fleas and other parasites. Several had severe eye and ear infections.

P.A.W.S. had to give all the dogs SubQ fluids throughout the first night in the shelter due to the severity of the dehydration. They were taken into our vet the very next morning, yet still, one, in particular, was critical. He was severely lethargic and so emaciated that his survival was grim. His leg muscles were so atrophied that you could see right through them. We are happy to report that all nine dogs survived, and are getting healthier and stronger every day. They are now happy, healthy, loved, and will never go hungry again. Thanks to you, our P.A.W.S .supporters, we can give compassionate care and life-saving help to animals in need. You are the heroes in these stories because without you, none of this would be possible. So we THANK YOU!
