Volusia County Fair & Youth Show

GENERAL RULES

1. The Management of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show has the right to amend, add to, interpret and administer the rules and regulations, and to arbitrarily settle and determine all questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or incident to the Volusia County Fair, and their decision will be final. Any complaints must be in writing within thirty (30) days of the date of the complaint and delivered to the Fair Office of the Volusia County Fair Assn., Inc. at 3150 E New York Ave. DeLand, FL 32724. Any evidence of fraud coming to the attention of the Fair Management will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
2. Exhibitors must live in Volusia County. Youth must meet age requirements as of September 1st, of the current year, and be enrolled and in attendance in an elementary school, high school, or home school in Volusia County at the time of entering items in the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show,
3. **Social Security or Federal ID Number:** If a Social Security Number or Federal ID Number is not provided, the Volusia County Fair reserves the right to not issue premium money or checks. Any exhibitor with a premium amount of \$100 or more will be required to provide a Social Security Number or Tax ID Number.
4. Premium Book and official entry forms are available online at: www.volusiacountyfair.com. A copy of the Premium Book may be obtained at the Fair Office (No mail or fax).
5. All exhibits entered for competition shall be subject to the control of the Superintendent of the department, with the approval of Fair management, in which they are exhibited. Exhibitors are not permitted to remove, handle, rearrange, improve or disfigure the same under any circumstances. No exhibit shall be removed in whole or part during the period of the Fair except by permission of the Fair Management. The Fair reserves the right to not accept late or incomplete entry forms.
6. **Removal of Exhibits:** Entry exhibits not picked up the Removal Day or Monday after the last day of the Fair will in be held in the Fair office for seven (7) days only. The Fair can not store any exhibits and therefore, the Fair Association assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits not removed on the Removal Day.
7. The Fair Management reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed unsuitable as a Volusia County Fair & Youth Show exhibit.
8. Decision of judges is final. Exhibitors, parents and general public are not allowed, in the building(s) during the judging of exhibit
9. **Judging Method - AMERICAN SYSTEM**
Exhibits in this system are compared against a standard of perfection, as well as against the other entries in the competition. All exhibits in a particular class are looked at and ranked with only one selected for first place, second place, third place, etc. If there are no high quality exhibits, at the judge's discretion, exhibits may be placed in the appropriate position, even if it is second or third place.
10. For rules and regulations governing each department, see rules in that department.
11. **Responsibility:** Upon signing the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show entry form, the exhibitor, parent and/or guardian agree that the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc. and the County of Volusia and/or it representatives are not to be held responsible for any exhibit entered for exhibition or for personal injury due to accidents, fire, theft or providential destruction. The Fair Association will exercise responsible vigilance in the care of exhibits for exhibition but exhibits are entered at owner's risk. Any exhibits entered into the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show may be photographed and used by Volusia County Fair Association, Inc. for advertising. The Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits from any cause and upon this condition only are exhibits accept.
12. **Premium Award Monies and Checks:**
 1. Premiums will be paid on the basis of the judging and cash award reports, which must be verified and signed by the department superintendent.
 2. Premium Monies and Checks are given on the Removal Day when exhibits are picked up.
 3. Premium checks awarded by the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show shall be cashed by the exhibitor within ninety (90) days from the last day of the Fair.
 4. Premium Monies awarded to an exhibitor, will be held at the Fair Office for sixth (60) days after the last day of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
 5. If the exhibitor fails to timely negotiate a check or collect money, after 90 days, all money due exhibitor shall belong to the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., and the exhibitor shall be deemed to have made an unconditional and irrevocable gift of said monies to the Volusia County Fair Association. Premium money and/or checks are not mailed.

1939 WORLD'S FAIR DIORAMA'S

The Diorama's from the 1939 World's Fair in New York were donated to the Volusia County Fair in 1982 by James Burkhalter. In 2007, the dioramas were redone to their original state by Mr. Burkhalter. The dioramas are on permanent display in "Mitchell's Old Plantation" by the Model Train Display.

As you enter "Mitchell's Old Plantation", you will step back to the days that are recalled as "The Good Old Days". Walking the through "Mitchell's Old Plantation", it seems that you are in the days of an era long ago.

When walking through the Old Planation Building, you will notice the preservation of energy - a fire-less cooker, a dog treadmill and many other interesting exhibits. There are horse drawn surreys, buggies, wagons, and a chuck wagon, hand tools crudely made of wood and stone, and handmade wood carvings and machines that were used for everyday basic needs.

Stop by the "Frank Bastler Rock Shop", in the Old Plantation Building, where you will see a large display of rocks, minerals and gems on display. There will be jewelry being made from gems, rocks and minerals.

1. The contestant must be a resident of Volusia County and attend a school or home school in Volusia County.
2. Age Limit: 14 -19 years of age and in high school (Single, never been married, not currently married; never been pregnant, and not now pregnant). Contestant must be 14 years of age as of September 1st of current year.
3. Contestants must attend rehearsal. NO EXCEPTIONS! Dress for rehearsal is casual.
4. Contestants must dress for judging competition in an evening or prom gown (full or tea length).
5. Contestants will compete at the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show on Opening Night of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show in the Tommy Lawrence Arena. (There is NO preliminary judging.)
6. The Miss Volusia County Fair Queen will assist with the Livestock Shows and other events during the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
7. Past queen's are not allowed to compete for a second time for the same title.
8. The semi - finalists will be named at the conclusion of Evening Gown Competition by decision of the judges.
All decisions of the judges are final.
9. The semi finalists will be interviewed, on stage. The Miss Volusia County Fair Queen, 1st Runner Up and 2nd Runner Up will be selected by decision of the judges. Decisions of the judges are final.
10. Each contestant will be judged on: Personality, Poise and Public Speaking.
11. The Volusia County Fair Association reserves the right to disqualify a contestant, and may prevent a contestant from participating in future Miss Volusia County Fair pageants, for conduct unbecoming to a contestant.
12. Each Contestant will receive their speech topic on the day of rehearsal.
13. Entry forms are available online at www.volusiacountyfair.com in the Exhibitor Handbook or at the Fair Office (No mail, fax or email).
14. Consent of Parent or Guardian: Applicants under 18 years of age must have the signed permission of a parent or legal guardian to participate in the pageant. The signature of a parent or legal guardian on the entry form will be considered as their consent.
15. The Superintendent shall have the final say on any deviation or conflict regarding rules.
16. The decision of judges is final.
17. Award money will be available, for pick up, at the Fair Office seven (7) days from the day of the pageant.
Award money awarded to a recipient and not collected, will be held at the Fair Office for sixty (60) days after the last day of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show. If the recipient fails to timely negotiate said check or collect money, after ninety (90) days, from the last day of the Fair, all award money due the recipient shall belong to the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., and the recipient shall be deemed to have made an unconditional and irrevocable gift of said money to the Volusia County Fair Association. Award money is not mailed.

RULES:

1. Contestant(s) must be a resident of Volusia County, and be in attendance in a school or home school in Volusia County. Contestants will be given one contestant and two parent passes Family performances, (Performances with more than one family, each contestant will be allowed one pass and only two parent passes).
2. Contestants must pre-register and attend the audition - no exceptions. Entry forms are to be handed in at the Fair Office (No mail, fax or email) or to the Superintendent no later than the deadline date. No entries on day of auditions and no walk ins.
3. Amateur acts only. No contestant will be considered if they have ever received a fee for performing.
4. Contestants will compete against their Age Division. Group acts will compete in Age Division of the oldest member. Contestants may compete in only one (1) Age Division.
5. Previous Senior Division 1st Place Winners are not eligible to compete in the talent contest. Junior Division 1st Place Winners may compete in the Senior Division when age requirements are met.
6. Sound Equipment: Sound equipment, microphones, CD player will be Sponsored and operated by Fair personnel.
7. Musical Instruments: The Fair does not provide musical instruments. Check with Superintendent on availability of a keyboard.
8. Props must be Sponsored by the contestant. Props are to be kept to a minimum, and will be the responsibility of the contestant for access to and from the stage for the auditions and show.
9. Acts may not exceed (four) 4 minutes. Points will be deducted for overtime. Acts will be timed at the audition and at the competition.
10. The same act must be performed for audition and at the competition.
11. Judging will be based on:
 - a. Talent (ability, difficulty, skill).
 - b. Presentation (poise, confidence, audience appeal).
 - c. Costume-Staging (age appropriate, clever, creative)
12. The Fair reserves the right to disallow any act that may be deemed unsuitable for the Volusia County Fair.
13. The Volusia County Fair has the right to disqualify a contestant, and may prevent a contestant from participating in future Amateur Talent Shows, for conduct unbecoming to a contestant.
14. Each contestant will be given a time their performance will be on show day. Performance times could vary and contestants must be flexible with changes that may occur.
15. The Superintendent shall have the final say on any deviation or conflict regarding rules.
16. The decision of judges is final.

Engineering & Technology Education - Department 1000

The Volusia County Fair Technology Education Program is an activity designed to encourage the understanding of technology and development of craftsmanship among secondary students enrolled in engineering and technology education. The program offers awards for excellence demonstrated at the county level competition at the Volusia County Fair, DeLand, Florida.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY:

Any entry made in school under the supervision of a technology education teacher and which qualifies according to the rules and regulations may be entered. At least 70% of the project must be fabricated in the school laboratory. Entries in Divisions 1001, 1002, 1003 and 1004 must be individual entries. Team/Class projects may be presented for display only. Division 1005 may be individual entries or team projects.

NUMBER OF ENTRIES:

All Divisions may be entered but only one (1) entry per Class. For example: you may enter one (1) entry of a residence drafting project and one (1) entry of an object drafting project and one (1) entry of an engineering project and one (1) entry of a metal table top object — these are all in different classes. You may NOT enter a drafting of an airplane engine and a drafting of another type of engine — these are in the same class. Entries in Divisions 1001, 1002, 1003 and 1004 must be individuals. Team/Class projects in Divisions 1001, 1002, 1003 and 1004 may be presented for display only.

JUDGING:

1. The Danish System of judging will be used where there can be numerous Blue Ribbon awards with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd awarded in Divisions 1001, 1002, and 1003.
2. Projects completed in the past school year are eligible for this year. Projects exhibited in the Fair last year are not eligible.
3. All 1st place winners in Divisions 1001, 1002 and 1003 only are judged against each other for the Best of Show Awards.
