## Weight Definitions

- GVWR (Gross Vehicle Weight Rating): The maximum permissible weight of a fully loaded recreational vehicle.
- GAWR (Gross Axle Weight Rating): The maximum permissible weight the axle is rated to carry.
- UVW (Unloaded Vehicle Weight): The total weight of the recreational vehicle as manufactured at the factory when separated from the tow vehicle.
- CCC (Cargo Carrying Capacity): Equal to the GVWR minus each of the following: UVW, full fresh (potable) water weight (including the hot water heater) @ 8.3#/3.76kg/gal., full LP-Gas weight.
- GCWR (Gross Combined Weight Rating): The maximum allowable loaded weight of the recreational vehicle with its tow vehicle. Actual GCWR may be limited by the sum of the GVWR and the installed hitch rated capacity.
