

Confession is available every Monday during Lent from 5:00 to 6:15 pm. Other times, by appointment.

Stations of the Cross are prayed in the church every Friday at 5 pm. Stations are always available on Facebook on the parish website.

Eucharistic Adoration: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament every Wednesday at 11:30 until the 12:00 mass.

Religious Education: our children are attending CCD classes in person and on line. Our First Communion and Confirmation classes are on schedule in their sacramental preparation.

In spite of the obstacles we may face, we can make this Lent a special time of grace for ourselves and others, so that when Easter arrives, we can celebrate with renewed joy and hope.

My prayer for us this Lent is that we may be filled to overflowing with God's love and with the grace to share that love with one another.
