Hello from Midway Nursing Home -

This message is your weekly COVID-19 update. There are no new positive COVID-19 cases for either residents or staff.

In order to maintain consistent and ongoing visitation, we will be doing window visits only for the foreseeable future. Per the latest NYSDOH guidance, PCR COVID tests will still be required within the prior 7 days of the scheduled visit. Visits will be scheduled according to resident unit as follows:

Monday – 4<sup>th</sup> Fl.; Tuesday – 5<sup>th</sup> Fl.; Wednesday – 6<sup>th</sup> Fl.; Thursday – 3<sup>rd</sup> Fl. & Friday – 2<sup>nd</sup> Fl.

Virtual visits are available daily. Please contact Social Services or Recreation to set this up.

We continue to test our residents who have not previously tested positive weekly and because Midway is currently in a “yellow” zone, our staff is being tested twice weekly per NYSDOH guidance. All new and readmissions are quarantined for 14 days.

COVID has not gone away. Please continue to always wear a mask when you are out, wash or sanitize your hands frequently and monitor yourself for symptoms. If you haven’t done so already, please speak to your healthcare provider about getting a flu shot as flu season is upon us. It is important that we all take care of ourselves.

We want to assure you that we are doing everything we can to keep the residents safe and appreciate your understanding and patience in these difficult times.
