Community Paramedic: Mike is working on putting a group together.

The Paramedic school paperwork is mostly done.

Program is on track for 5 Bellingham and 3 Ferndale Paramedics in September.

Hospital:

A radio only day on a monthly basis would be beneficial for training.

Becky presented an Outcomes report that shows under/over triage. Their aim is for less than 5%, but was over 9%. The report shows that over 80% of the patients that were under triaged were

elderly.

There needs to be stricter geriatric protocols for things such as rib fractures, and bleeding injuries.

If there are concerns that might not fall into lighter mechanism please push for more.
