All are invited to attend.</p>	<p><u>THE EASTER SEASON:</u> The Easter season is celebrated during the seven weeks between Easter and Pentecost. These fifty days of Easter are celebrated as one great Feast Day known as "the Great Sunday". Through the entire Easter season the triumphant "Alleluia" continues to be heard as we rejoice in the hope of the resurrection.</p> <p>The Ascension of Jesus reminds us that we are pilgrims on a journey, that we are "only passing through" on this earth. Meanwhile, we have work to do. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the apostles, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations . . ." So too we, like the apostles, are challenged to witness to Christ in our daily lives – in our homes, in our churches, in our local community, and, yes, even to the ends of the earth, leading others to become true disciples of the Lord Jesus. As we strive to always be credible witnesses of the Lord Jesus, let us take courage from the words spoken to the first eleven disciples and, yes, even to us today, "And remember, I am with you always to the end of the age".</p> <div>  <p>Ascension</p> </div>	
<p>MAY 22 - VICTORIA DAY</p> <div>  <p>The birthday (May 24, 1819) of Queen Victoria has been celebrated as a holiday in Canada West (now Ontario) since 1845; it became a national holiday in 1901, the year that Queen Victoria died. Although the Sovereign changed along the years, the day of her/his birthday celebration remained. In 1952, it was established on the Monday preceding May 25. Today it is appropriate to offer prayers for King Charles III, for Canada, and for justice and peace in the world.</p> </div>

BAPTISM PREPARATION: The baptism of a child is a very important event in the life of the child, the child's family, and the parish community. To help parents enter more fully into the celebration of their child's baptism, St. Joseph's Parish offers a Baptism Preparation Course by appointment. Parents along with godparents are expected to attend the Baptism Preparation Course before the baptism of the child. Please call the Parish Office to register.

MAY 21 - WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY: Today Catholics are invited to reflect upon the media of social communication (films, radio, television, newspapers, audiovisuals) and how these influence our lives and promote values that lead to a more fully human society. The Church's ministry is twofold. The media can be used to help promote the Gospel. At the same time, as receivers of the materials presented by the media, the faithful have a duty to support and promote worthwhile presentations on media and to reject those which promote values contrary to spiritual growth.

MAY 24 - WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CHURCH IN CHINA: This day is designed to express solidarity for Chinese Catholics, with the global Church praying with and for the Church in China. Because the Church in China has had a turbulent relationship with the state, this has created great tension, forcing many Catholics to worship in secret and sending Bishops underground. Introduced by Pope Benedict XVI in 2007, this date was chosen because it is the feast of Our Lady Help of Christians, who is honoured at a shrine in Sheshan, just outside of Shanghai.

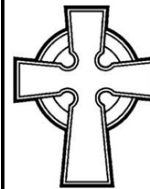
