~~~~~ Rule I ~~~~~

The Village council of the Village of New Munich shall hold regular sessions on the last Saturday of each month during the year at 7-30 O'clock P.M. unless such day be a national holiday, then the day after, unless the council shall otherwise direct.

~~~~~ Rule II ~~~~~

In case of the absence of the President, a Quorum of the council may appoint one of their members to act in place of the absent officer, protem.

In case there be no Quorum present, then those present may adjourn from time to time.

~~~~~ Rule III ~~~~~

If there is less than a Quorum present at any meeting, the Recorder shall so note in his Minute Book, under the date on which the meeting was to be held, and note the names of the members absent.

~~~~~ Rule IV ~~~~~

The following shall be the order of business:

- 1st Calling the Roll.
- 2nd Reading the minutes of the previous meeting.
- 3 New Business.
- 4th Reports of the Committees.
- 5th unfinished business.
- 6th Adjournment. A motion to adjourn may always be in order.

~~~~~ Rule V ~~~~~

If no objection is made to the minutes of the council, when read, it shall be taken as the sense of the council that the same stand approved.

### Rule VI

Upon a vote upon any question, motion or resolution each member of the council present shall be required to vote thereon, if requested by any member; provided, said request to be of force, shall be made previous to putting the motion or resolution to vote, and in such cases the recorder shall enter in the minutes their respective names of the members voting for or against the question.

### Rule VII

The president or presiding officer of the council shall at the first meeting after the general election, or soon thereafter appoint the following standing committees, unless otherwise provided for. Each committee to consist of three members, viz:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Committee on finance
- 2<sup>nd</sup> " on License
- 3<sup>d</sup>. " on ordinances
- 4<sup>th</sup>. " on Streets and Alleys
- 5<sup>th</sup>. " on Fire Department.

All Committees to examine and report on all matters referred to them.

### Rule VIII

All officers appointed by the village council shall be appointed by ballot, and shall have a majority of the votes present at such voting.

### Rule VIII

Special meetings may be called by the President at any time when he deems it necessary for the interests of the Village. The President shall also call a special meeting at any time when petitioned for in writing by two members of the council, notice of the time of said meeting to be served on each member of the council by the Recorder.

Rule X

The rules of parliamentary practice embraced in Sushing's Manual, shall govern the council in all cases to which they are applicable, and in which they are not in consistence with the standing rules and order of the council.

### Ordinance No. 1

Regulating the sale of, and traffic in spirituous, vinous, malt and fermented liquors and providing for licensing the same

The village council of the village of New Munich do ordain as follows

Section I. No person, person, company or corporation shall sell, barter, dispose of, or deal in any spirituous, malt, fermented, vinous or mixed intoxicating liquor of any kind within the corporate limits of the village of New Munich, without first having obtained a license therefor

Section II. Any person, person, company, or corporation applying to said council for license to sell, barter, dispose of, or deal in spirituous, vinous, malt fermented or mixed intoxicating liquor within said village, shall before such license is granted, execute to the said village and file with the recorder of said village, a bond in the penal sum of five hundred dollars (\$500-), with two or more sufficient sureties to be approved by the village council, conditional as required by section two of chapter 16, of the statutes of Minnesota, of the year of 1878, and amendments thereto, and shall pay to the village treasurer of said village, the sum of money hereinafter named, to wit:

For a general license to vend, ~~sell~~ sell in, sell and dispose of such liquors in said village, the sum of ~~Five~~ <sup>One</sup> hundred dollars, lawful money of the United States, for one year or fractional part of a year.

All saloons and other places where any such liquors are sold or kept for sale, within the limits of said village - excepting hotels and drug stores - shall be closed at the hour of eleven o'clock each and every night and be kept closed from that hour until the hour of five o'clock on the following morning, and from the hour of eleven o'clock on each and every Saturday night until the hour of five o'clock on the following morning, on every day, as also on every general and special election day. And no person,

persons, company or corporation shall sell, barter, deal in, dispose of or give away, any such liquors within said village during any of the time or times during which such saloons or other places are required to be kept closed, as above provided, excepting sales of such liquors made upon physicians prescriptions for medicinal purposes only.

Nor shall any person persons, company or corporation sell, barter, furnish or give away any such liquors within said village, to any minor person, pupil or student of any public school, academy, seminary or other institution of learning, nor to any intoxicated or intemperate person or habitual drunkard.

Section III Any person, persons, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than One hundred Dollars; besides the cost of suit in all cases, or be committed to the county jail of Stearns County or the village jail of the village of New Munich not to exceed ninety days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the village justice.

Section V

Upon the conviction of any person, persons, company or corporation, of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, the village council may at their first regular or special meeting thereafter, declare the license of such person persons, company or corporation revoked and annulled and may order to forthwith close up the place of business so licensed and any violation of any of the conditions of the bond referred to in section two of this ordinance shall work a forfeiture of the amt. of the penalty thereof, in favor of said Village of New Munich which may be recovered in civil action in any district court of this state.
