

God's Word The 1611 King James Bible

The 1611 King James Bible was translated from the "Texus Receptus" (Received Text). These are the manuscripts all the Early Christians recognized as the Inerrant, Infallible, Word of God. And these are the scriptures which came from Antioch were the disciples were first called Christians (Acts 11:26). All the translators came to an untimely end at the hands of God's Antichrist enemies.

All the other Bible translations are actually Roman Catholic which came from Alexandria, Egypt that are the Vaticanus and Siniaticus manuscripts. In spite of the fact that the Vaticanus and Siniaticus disagree with each other over 3,000 times and disagree with the Texus Receptus 5,337 times just in the Gospels alone. Also 998 other manuscripts disagree with them also. Whenever Satan's counterfeit manuscripts disagreed with God's Texus Receptus, the translators choose to use Satan's instead. The American Bible Publishers have even taken the Letter of Dedication out of the front of all King James Bibles today. The Siniaticus manuscript was found in a pile of trash in 1844 at St. Catherine's Roman Catholic Monastery, near Mt. Sinai.

The Vaticanus manuscript was found in the Vatican's Library in 1481. It omits Genesis 1:1-46:28, Psalms 106-138, Matthew 16:2,3, all of Paul's Letters, Hebrews 9:14-13:25, and all of Revelation, and lots more.

Gunpowder

While the U.S. has its Fourth of July, complete with fireworks and revelry, England also has November 5 and it appears their celebration outdoes ours. All over the country "bonfire societies" field multiple parades complete with massive firework displays. One example in the news recently was a small town of 16,000 called Lewes, which hosts some 60,000 visitors who joined the festivities.

So, what is so special about November 5? It's Guy Fawkes Day!

Those who know the history of the holiday, know the significance of the "gunpowder plot" that got Fawkes and some of his buddies executed. But, if Fawkes had succeeded in igniting the fuse to 36 barrels of gunpowder, you and I might have a very different Bible to read today.

The year was 1605, just 6 years before the publication of the King James Bible that became the standard English scriptures for some 400 years. King James had been petitioned by the Puritans to authorize the translation of a "new and completely accurate" English Bible. He immediately commissioned over 50 scholars from Oxford and

Cambridge to begin the work. The men chosen were the most learned of their day not only in linguistics but biblical theology. Many of them were fluent in up to 14 languages.

All this was happening in the middle of a pitched battle between the leaders of the Reformation and the Vatican. And the Bible was the prize in that war. For over 100 years the Reformers had fought to print the Bible in the language of the people. The Vatican had commissioned the Jesuits and the Dominicans with the task of destroying those Bibles. Politics had become one of the battlefields with the rulers of England alternating between Protestant and Catholic.

At this point, King James was Protestant and almost literally had a bull's eye on his back. Jesuit agents cooked the "gunpowder plot" to tunnel under the Parliament building and set off a massive explosive while it was in session. Their hope was to kill King James and as many of the Members of Parliament as possible.

Guy Fawkes was enlisted by the pope to carry out the plan. He and about half-a-dozen other men started the tunnel and eventually positioned 36 barrels of gunpowder in place. In their attempt to carry out their plan, they met one problem after another so that, looking back, the Lord was surely toying with their little plan. During the digging, they hit an unexpected wall underground. But a cellar was discovered that gave them the required access. Next, Parliament delayed meeting for several months and the powder

got wet and had to be replaced. Finally one of the men wrote a letter warning a Catholic friend to stay away from the building on a certain date. The letter ended up in the hands of the king who discovered the scheme just hours before the targeted meeting.

November 5th was legislated a national day of thanksgiving for deliverance from "papists." Today, it is celebrated as a fun festival with few recognizing the continued dangers of Roman Catholicism. But had the pope not lost that battle, you and I might be reading a Roman Catholic Bible, if we were even allowed to possess one.

But the story of the war waged by the Vatican to stop God's word for the common people is not over. Today gunpowder is not the only weapon of choice, it is ecumenism and polluted bibles. David W. KJB: "Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the **Son of God**?" John 9:35

NAS: "Jesus heard that they had put him out; and finding him, He said, Do you believe in the Son of Man (not God)?" John 9:35

KJB: "But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him." *Mark 5:6*

NAS: "And seeing Jesus from a distance, he ran and bowed down (not worshipped) before Him." Mark 5:6

KJB: "And they **worshipped** him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy." *Luke 24:52*

NAS: "And they (omitted worshipped him) returned to Jerusalem with great joy." Luke 24:52

KJB: "But thou Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting." Micah 5:2

RSV: "But you, O Bethlehem, Ephrathah, who are little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose **origin** (God, Christ had no beginning, he always was), is from of old, from ancient days." *Micah* 5:2

KJB: "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass." Zechariah 9:9

RSV: "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Lo, your king comes

NAS: "Therefore since Christ has suffered in the flesh (he didn't suffer for himself), arm yourselves also with the same purpose." 1Peter4:1

KJB: "He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee." Luke

RSV: "Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee (He is not here, but is risen, is missing)." Luke 24:6

KJB: "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ." 7itus 2:13

NAS: "Looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus (His glory, and not Him in person)." 7itus 2:13

KJB: "And Jesus answered him saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, **but by every word of God**." *Luke 4:4*

NAS: "And Jesus answered him, It is written, Man shall not live on bread alone (but by every word of God is missing)." Luke 4:4

KJB: "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (God with us)." Psaiah 7:14. Mat 1:23

RSV: "Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold a **young woman** shall conceive and bear a son and shall call his name Immanuel (any woman can have a son, but only a virgin could have God's son)." *?saiah 7:14*

Good News: "Well then, the Lord himself will give you a sign: a young woman who is pregnant will have a son and will name him 'Immanuel' (not a virgin)." Isalah 7:14

KJB: "Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing **I** know not a man (she was saying she was a virgin)?" Luke 1:34

RSV: "And Mary said to the angel, How shall this be, since **I have no husband** (any woman can have a baby without a husband)?" Luke 1:34

KJB: "And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him." Luke 2:33

NAS: "And His father and mother were amazed at the things which were being said about Him (Joseph was not his father, God was)." Luke 2:33

KJB: "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby." *Peter 2:2*

RSV: "Like newborn babes, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up to salvation ("Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us." 7ttue 3:5)." (Peter 2:2)

KJB: "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." John 3:36 NAS: "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him (Changed from beliveth not to obey not. "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved." Acta 16:31)." John 3:36

KJB: "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life." John 6:47 **NAS**: "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes has eternal life (Believes what? not on Jesus)." John 6:47

Living: "So the Lord was very angry, for Manasseh was an evil man, in God's opinion (God has no opinion, God is always right)." ZKings 21:6
