Highway Superintendent Report:

Working on patching the dirt roads, Gassmann, Cory, Gath, cutting brush on Standish and Buffalo roads. Truck 206 needed rear brakes / transmission – costly work completed. We have been shut down from work, back to work now. Everyone is handling the virus protocols well, wearing their mask, wiping down surfaces at the end of the day.

<u>Town Clerk Report:</u> Our Town website visits for March 2020 were 1688, April 202 were 1504. The Towns total revenue for the month of April 2020 was \$385.00, \$315.00 for dog licenses and \$70.00 for zoning fees. We had 32 dog renewal licenses and 11 new license. To the general fund, \$148.00, Dogs were \$75.00, \$70.00 for zoning. We disbursed \$195.00 to Wyoming County, \$45.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs. The link information on our website regarding Spectrum, is still not currently working.

Supervisor May discussed with the Board that Spectrum is finally set to move out the product in July, the Town Hall will be able to have the internet product. Spoke with Ryan Hicks, there were given 120 day extension on their permit, d/t delay in getting products that they will need to complete the station.
