To the Sherburn and Welcome City Councils,

The department logged 116 calls for service in the month of May. This puts the total for the year at 550. We are up significantly in the number of calls compared to prior years at this time.

Each city was given a proposed Recreational Fire Ordinance to review and approve. As it currently stands, the City of Welcome only allows the burning of leaves during specific months of the year and Sherburn allows no open burning within the city limits. The new ordinance would allow for recreational fires in each city with certain requirements. Many residents in both communities already enjoy having fires and the have been allowed even though they were technically illegal. The new ordinance will give specific guideline that must be met if the resident wishes to have a fire during the summer months. If you have any questions regarding the proposed ordinance, please let me know and minor modifications can be made.

The Sherburn Festival is coming up the week-end of the 22nd. The department will again help out with the fireman's dance on Friday night as well as the parade on Sunday.
