

DANCE INSTRUCTOR **(part-time, weekends)**

Dance Instructor is directly accountable to the Artistic Coordinator and is responsible for leading dance classes for individuals or groups of people. Dance Instructor must treat all students fairly, irrespective of their race, colour, creed, social standing, sex or ability in order to make it possible for each student to develop his/her educational, social and moral potential to the full.

- Provide a safe environment—physical, emotional, and psychological and show respect for all students through a fair and equitable distribution of time and the use of positive reinforcement, constructive criticism, and acknowledgment of achievements
- Offer challenges that will raise them to the next level
- Provide appropriate discipline and engage in an appropriate relationship while establishing clear expectations for behavior and attire
- Observe and evaluate student work to determine student progress or make suggestions for improvement
- Accompany students to dance recitals, performances and other events
- Communicate clearly and concisely with parents and/or students about student progress, expectations regarding appropriate behaviour and compliance with society's policies
