**Resident Center:** Please log in to submit repair tickets and other requests. This ensures your concerns are promptly addressed and documented.

**Text Line:** For urgent matters, you can reach us directly via text. This system alerts us immediately and keeps track of all communications.

Additionally, all **voicemail messages** are automatically emailed to our team, ensuring nothing is missed. We all receive these emails, so your concerns are always seen by multiple team members.
