Farm Fair Open Horse Show Rules For All Shows

1. An **ORIGINAL** Negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the show date is required. The Show Secretary must see the Coggins before you will be permitted to exhibit.
2. Rider's grade in school is as of Sept. 2014 to June 2015.
3. Riders will not be permitted to show without a signed release form. For riders under age 18 THIS RELEASE CAN ONLY BE SIGNED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN AND A WITNESS.
4. These shows will be run in accordance with 4-H rules, regulations and Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct is posted at the Secretary's Booth. Horses must be at least 4 years old to show. The decision of the judge will be final. Should any questions or disputes arise, they shall be referred to the Show Committee.
5. Unruly and/or unsound horses will not be permitted. Determination of the above will be at the discretion of the judge and/or Show Committee. No stallions are allowed.
6. The Burlington County 4-H Horse Advisory Council, the 4-H Youth Development Program, the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders, the Judges, the Show Committee, and/or Burlington County Farm Fair will not be responsible for loss or damage of property and/or injury to horse, rider, or spectator.
7. A properly fitted ASTM/SEI Safety Helmet with harness properly fitted and securely fastened must be worn in all classes and whenever mounted.
8. **An open check or cash payment is required at signup.**

Cloverbud Day Rules:

1. Minimum age for riders is 3 years old. Maximum age is 3rd grade. Grades are as of September 1, 2014.
2. Horses may be used twice (by 2 different riders) in classes LL1, LL3, LL4, 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10
3. Lead Line may not cross enter into Cloverbud classes.
4. **Cantering is not allowed on Cloverbud Day.**
5. Attire - long pants, shirts with sleeves and collar, and boots MUST be worn. No riding sneakers of any type.
6. Flag Race - Trot to Barrel, take flag from bucket one - place flag in bucket two - Trot back to start.
7. Musical Sacks - Ride around the ring. When the music stops, dismount and run to the nearest sack. Both feet must be on the sack, must run forward around the ring, not back. We remove sacks until there is one left.
8. Sack Race - Everyone trots down to the other end, dismounts, puts on a sack and hops back. Handlers will hold the horses.
