Old Testament Lesson Isaiah 35:1-10

1 The wilderness and the dry land shall be glad; the desert shall rejoice and blossom like the crocus; 2 it shall blossom abundantly and rejoice with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, the majesty of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the LORD, the majesty of our God. 3 Strengthen the weak hands, and make firm the feeble knees. 4 Say to those who have an anxious heart, "Be strong, fear not! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, with the recompense of God. He will come and save you." 5 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf unstopped; 6 then shall the lame man leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute sing for joy.

For waters break forth in the wilderness, and streams in the desert; **7** the burning sand shall become a pool, and the thirsty ground springs of water; in the haunt of jackals, where they lie down, the grass shall become reeds and rushes. **8** And a highway shall be there, and it shall be called the Way of Holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it. It shall belong to those who walk on the way; even if they are fools, they shall not go astray. **9** No lion shall be there, nor shall any ravenous beast come up on it; they shall not be found there,

but the redeemed shall walk there. <u>10</u> And the ransomed of the LORD shall return and come to Zion with singing; everlasting joy shall be upon their

heads: they shall obtain gladness and joy, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

New Testament Lesson 1 Corinthians 3:1-9

<u>1</u> But I, brothers, could not address you as spiritual people, but as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. <u>2</u> I fed you with milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for it. And even now you are not yet ready, <u>3</u> for you are still of the flesh. For while there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not of the flesh and behaving only in a human way? <u>4</u> For when one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos," are you not being merely human?

<u>5</u> What then is Apollos? What is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, as the Lord assigned to each. <u>6</u> I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. <u>7</u> So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth. <u>8</u> He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor. <u>9</u> For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building.

Gospel Lesson John 10:22-42

22 At that time the Feast of Dedication took place at Jerusalem. It was winter, **23** and Jesus was walking in the temple, in the colonnade of Solomon. **24** So the Jews gathered around him and said to him, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly." **25** Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name bear witness about

me, <u>26</u> but you do not believe because you are not among my sheep. <u>27</u> My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. <u>28</u> I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. <u>29</u> My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. <u>30</u> I and the Father are one."

31 The Jews picked up stones again to stone him. 32 Jesus answered them, "I have shown you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you going to stone me?" 33 The Jews answered him, "It is not for a good work that we are going to stone you but for blasphemy, because you, being a man, make yourself God." 34 Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your Law, 'I said, you are gods'? 35 If he called them gods to whom the word of God came—and Scripture cannot be broken— 36 do you say of him whom the Father consecrated and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'? 37 If I am not doing the works of my Father, then do not believe me; 38 but if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me and I am in the Father." 39 Again they sought to arrest him, but he escaped from their hands.

<u>40</u> He went away again across the Jordan to the place where John had been baptizing at first, and there he remained. <u>41</u> And many came to him. And they said, "John did no sign, but everything that John said about this man was true." <u>42</u> And many believed in him there.


