With 2022 rapidly drawing to a close and Dogs around the country working on big finishes to local Toys for Tots and similar programs to bring smiles to children's faces, it carries on a common thread for the MODD. A thread which includes the welfare of children, wounded warriors, veterans in need and of our own members when faced with challenges. All laudable efforts where you are making a positive impact in your communities. If not already doing so, I encourage you to see how you might involve organized local youth groups, whether Young Marines, Sea Cadets, Scouts, Civil Air Patrol or high school groups in your efforts. These groups are frequently searching for community projects to be involved in and while your efforts can benefit, so can theirs, all while the youth have an opportunity to meet and work with Marines who have, lived service before self, and can be outstanding

role models; something many youths today are lacking or looking in the wrong places for.

Speaking of community efforts, where fund raising events are concerned there is no lack of ideas around the country with Pounds and Packs running the gamut, from raffles to SOS breakfasts. Still, I occasionally hear about Pounds struggling with fund raising due to a lack of funds to purchase an item to raffle or not enough Dogs to tackle a larger event like a breakfast or dinner. If your Pound is one of these and you're looking for a way to raise funds for the Kennel Children's Hospital fund here is a relatively easy one you can start with a minimal outlay of big bones and two or more Dogs ready to put in a few hours. It is the MODD Yellow Rose program, the roses are currently \$30 per gross. For orders or inquiries, the Pound should email MODDRoses@gmail.com. The company invoices using PayPal. The invoice can be paid via PayPal or with a card payment. Point of contact is John or Brittany Foster. Work with your local veteran friendly stores, gun shows or other suitable venues for dates and times they will let you set up to take donations for the roses and pass out information to any Marines on your detachment and the League. This has proven to be very successful for many



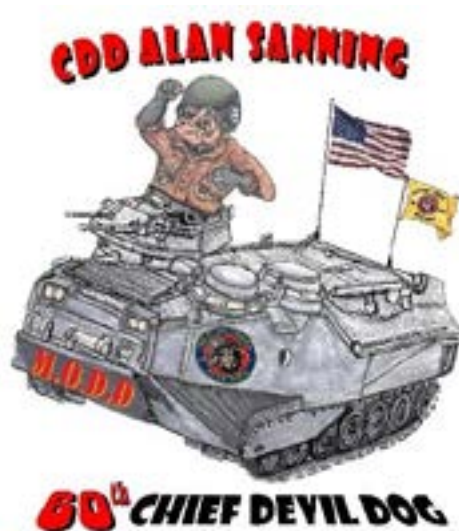
Pounds.

On the subject of success, while there are many Pounds and Packs who have maneuvered through IRS requirements to successfully get up to date and submit the necessary Form 990 – series returns on past years and regain their tax-exempt status, we still have others that are in a revoked status and in danger of having their charters suspended. The good news is we have resources to help Dog Robbers work through these issues, no need to feel overwhelmed. Each Division Vice Chief Devil Dog has been forwarded a list of those Pounds and Packs who appear on the IRS website as delinquent or revoked, so you can start there and check your Pound or Packs status. In the library on the Kennel website, under the Publications tab you will find a step-by-step guide on how to reinstate. If you need further assistance reach out to the Kennel Dog Robber, PDD Janice Hartley and she has quite a few duty experts she can point you to for further assistance. Let's make 2023 the year we finally resolve these issues. For those in good standing, take the 10 or 15 minutes to submit your 990's and maintain your tax-exempt status.

Calling all Dogs, the Mid-Winter Staff Conference and MODD Mini-Growl in Norfolk, VA will be upon on us in no time. All members of the MODD, regardless of degree, may attend and howl with us on February 24th at the Mini-Growl. By the time this WOG goes out Christmas, Hanukkah and New Years will already be in the past. I hope everyone had a great holiday season.

It has been remarkably busy since my last article. I have been collaborating with the Honorable Dog Robber and her Assistants in compiling the Kennel list for 990's and Incorporation paperwork. To date all of the Pack Leaders have received spread sheets to include their Pack and Pounds. I hope everyone has received their copies. If not, please reach out to your Pack Leader to see where you stand with compliance. I have been staying in contact with all DVCDD's and asked to be kept in the loop with any issues that may pop up. There have been some but, as of today there is nothing in the swamp. That is a good thing and means that everyone is trying to work things out on their own level.

In my last WOG article, we spoke about updating your Pack Bylaws to get in line with the Kennel. To date I have only received 3 Pack Bylaws to approve which have been and 2 Pounds sent me their Bylaws for approval, which have also been approved. This is a bit disheartening to me. Please, review your Bylaws and get them updated. I would suggest even going a step further and seeing when the last time your Bylaws were amended. The Kennel Bylaws have the dates in the margin of when a particular bylaw had been changed. If that needs to be done, then take care of it at the same time.

At the Supreme Growl I discussed adding Administrative Procedures in the Kennel Bylaws. This project is still in the works but has been paused due to the issues with the 990's. The Bylaw Committee will discuss this again at Mid-Winter. I put together a training class on Passport stamps right out of the Obedience school and posted it on my YouTube Channel here is the link. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kvMGQv5_zPM&t=64s. Use the Obedience School at your disposal and put together your own classes. If there is something you may be interested in seeing shoot me an email with an idea and if I can, I will put together something for everyone. We are getting to that time of year where Divisions will be holding their Conferences. Vice Chiefs remember if you are holding the Growl make it fun. Have a plan and work the plan. Get the business part of it done but, then give them a reason to want to come back next year. I look forward to seeing everyone at the Mini Supreme Growl in Norfolk in February. Remember that this is open to all Degrees of Dogs so if you can please come out and show your support to the Kennel.

In closing please remember if you wish to revise repeal or amend a Bylaw you must follow Article XIII which states:

ARTICLE XIII - AMENDING OF BYLAWS

Section 1301 - Method of Amending

A. All Devil Dogs, Pounds and Packs may seek to revise repeal or amend these Bylaws by submitting their proposals in typewritten or legible form, using the exact wording intended for the change, to the Honorable Kennel Smart Dog no later than 15 March prior to the opening date of the Supreme Growl of the Kennel at which their proposals are to be considered. All proposals must contain the identity of the maker or submitter, otherwise they will not be considered. The Honorable Kennel Smart Dog will propagate the proposals without comment by having the Honorable Kennel Barking Dog publish all proposals in the Woof-O-gram, the Order's house organ, and/or by mailing all proposals to each Pound Keeper and Pack Leader. In both cases, the proposed changes shall be distributed so that

they are received by each Pack Leader and Pound Keeper no later than 15 May prior to the opening date of the Supreme Growl of the Kennel at which such proposed revision, repeal or amendment is to be considered. The said notice shall include the proposed changes to the Articles, Sections and Paragraphs to be revised, repealed or amended. In addition to this, proposed changes may be posted on an official Kennel Web Site in their entirety.

B. The provisions of sub-paragraph "A" above will be construed to have been met, provided that the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber makes every reasonable effort to notify the Pedigreed Devil Dogs in each Pound and Pack that proposed Bylaw amendments to be considered at the ensuing Supreme Growl of the Kennel have been provided to the Pound and Pack Dog Robbers and, that copies of said amendments shall be available upon written request from the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber by mail up to two (2) weeks prior to the Supreme Growl of the Kennel or, by request, in person from the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber's staff in the Kennel Dog House prior to the Supreme Growl of the Kennel.

C. Upon the written request of any Kennel Stray to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber, copies of said amendments shall be provided as outlined in paragraph B.

The Hellcat Pistol is the highest capacity micro-compact 9mm in the world and is ready to accept the Sentinel Sight.

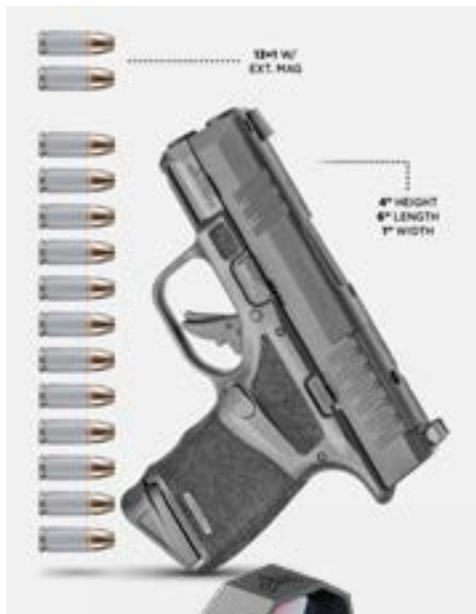

KENNEL DOG TRAINER REPORT

As your newly elected Kennel Dog Trainer, I would like to introduce myself. My name is Lisa Ciesielski (pronounced C-shell-ski), and I was born and raised in Georgia. I enlisted in the US Marine Corps in 1978 and left active service in 1986 holding the rank of Sergeant. I live in Havelock, NC right outside of MCAS Cherry Point, where I retired as a civil service employee in 2021. I have been active in my church and community and joined the Marine Corps League in 2011 and the MODD in 2013. I am currently the Dog Trainer for my Pounds (143, 210 & 370), Pack (NC) and Kennel.

As the Dog Trainer, I must ask that you follow the prescribed rules of filing a “Notice of Death” (NOD) for our deceased Dogs. The Pound Dog Trainer creates the NOD from their Pound, it is forwarded electronically to the Pack Dog Trainer, and they send it to the Kennel Dog Trainer. Once that is completed, the Dog is removed from the roster and the family receives a condolence card. Failure to follow this sequence means the Dog isn’t being recognized for his passing and the family continues to receive mail for the deceased which is very disconcerting.

Bear in mind that this is the same procedure the MCL Chaplain must follow and must be completed in a timely manner. I am also tasked with keeping a list of Deceased Dogs so I can report and hold a Memorial Service at the Grand Growl and at the Mid-Winter Conference Growl. If I haven’t received the NOD, your Dog will not be able to receive a final recognition.

So now for some housekeeping items you're probably wondering why these look so familiar, that's because these are some of the most important things that need to be done and passed on for Dogs who are advancing.

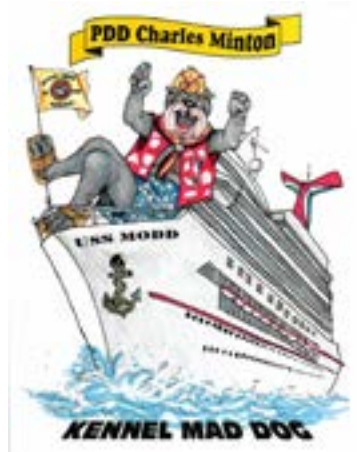

Several changes were implemented by myself and the Dog Robber, all dues are now entered under your dog tag number. This will allow us to track payment by the dog, before they were under the pound in which the dog is a member. This does require more work but also ensures that transmittals are accurate.

I have been working my paws to the bones entering all past and present dogs into Quick Books.

I can say that we are making a great deal of progress and should have it completed with all the information we currently have by Mid-Winter.

While all you dogs are hanging out in your dog houses this winter, we are looking for donations of items to raffle or auction at Mid-Winter to raise funds for the Kennel and/or Children's Hospital fund. If you have anything you would like to donate, could you please let us know as soon as possible.

Working with the Quarter Master the old trailer has been traded in and the new one purchased. It then went to the Graphics shop to have it wrapped. Our original budget for the project was \$23,335.49 BIG BONES.

I am please to report that we came in under budget by \$7,720.53 BIG BONES!! Big win for the kennel. The Passport and Children's Hospital fund currently sits at \$22,000.00 BIG BONES as of November 30th.

On a personal note, "The Real" and I had the opportunity to chaperone or adult babysitting "The Chosen Few Reunion" in Arlington, VA in September. Most of them in their last 90's is an amazing group of Gentlemen. If anyone in your family has served in the Chosen Few please sign up as a legacy member.



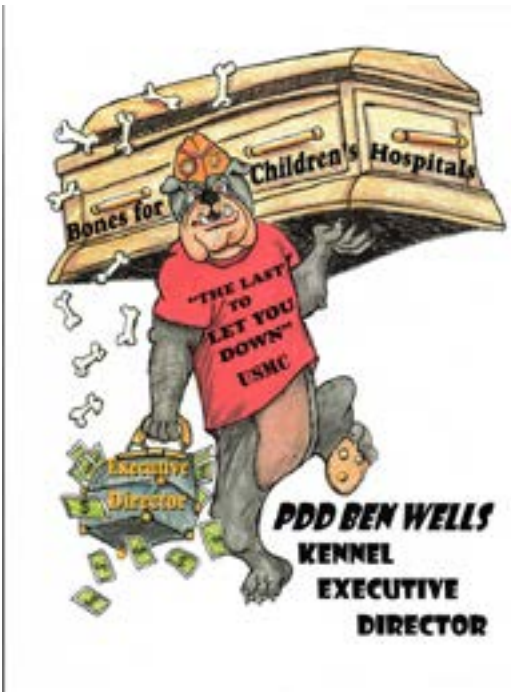

We are also always on the lookout for new things that will help us run things even better. The websites are both running smoothly and there seems to be a good bit of traffic to them, that is a good thing, that means people are using them. Another indication of this actually is the large amount of calls and emails I have been getting regarding the Password protected library page. So here is some information on that.

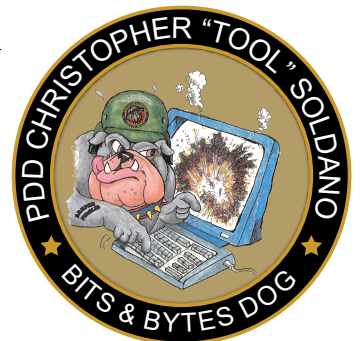
We currently have two separate Library pages, the regular one holds all the forms and manuals and classes and any other miscellaneous information that the kennel needs to put there. That is the main page that everyone needs to go to for all the main things. The second page is the Password protected Library page, this page hold things like Scratchings from meetings and links to special committee folders for some others from certain committees. Because some of those scratchings contain certain financial data, it is better to keep that information on a restricted access page. However, that page is open to any member that would like to look at it. with that being said, the password for that page is: WoofWoof. Again it is not a public page so only give that password to actual members please.

Staff pages have seen an improvement with its organization and I think that it has helped. We still have our Bord of Trustees page and our PCDD pages and the division page has also not changed much, however, we have changed the way that the other staff is organized. The Headquarters staff page consists of all those that have the primary roles in the jobs they hold. The secondary staff page contains all the Deputies and subsequent staff for all of those positions. This new layout seems to work better for the flow of information.

Speaking of information, this year we have implemented a new way of raising some Kennel funds and started working with some digital Raffle technologies. By doing this we will be able to reach a broader number of members in a much easier way than ever before. However, this still requires Dogs to be involved, please spread the word and the information. The QR code can be scanned by almost every smartphone out there. So please share it as much as you can. Simply display the QR code on your phone and let someone else scan the image, it will take them right to the raffle page, its that easy. The link is also available and is typically shared with the QR code. It should work in almost every Internet browser out there.

Ok, now the database. We moved onto a new platform this past year that will enable us to utilize our website to access the database and have better usage for our members. However, before we can make that happen, the data itself needs to be fixed, so we do not end up with severe issues. So far the past several months, many people have been working like crazy to fix, sort, and verify the data, all to make sure that we are running as smooth as possible. Historian & 51st Chief Devil Dog: PCDD Don Garland



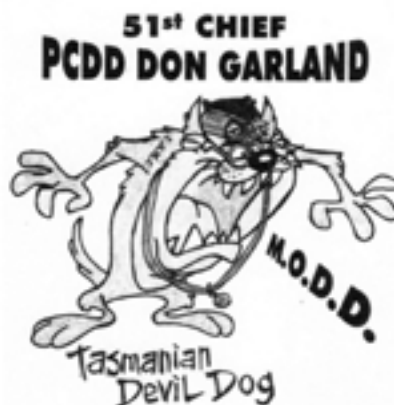

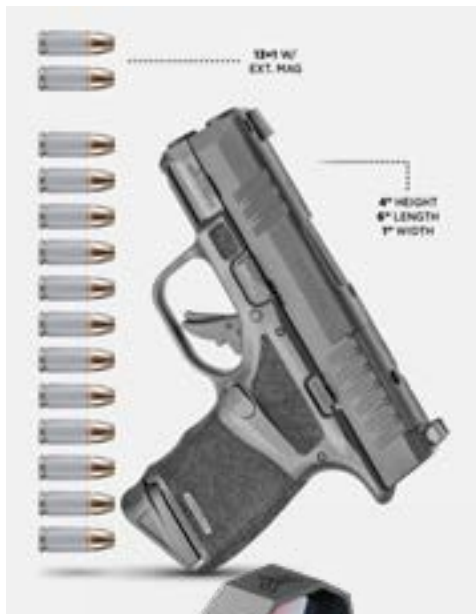

I want to talk about these keywords.

INTEGRITY, INTESTINAL FORTITUDE and TRANSPARENCY.

These key word definitions should be a guide for how your daily operations should run, being pound, pack for all MODD business.

If there is a blank, it means either it wasn't filled out on the ROI or hasn't been sent in yet. If there is an issue with the IRS, then it is annotated in red. "Due" means if you're on a Fiscal Year reporting status, then your filing should have been done by 15 November 2022. "Past Due" means either you are one or more years behind and maybe in jeopardy of being REVOKED! If the column is blank, either you are on a calendar year filing status, and it is not due yet or there is no issue with the IRS. The State Filing verification is taking longer than expected for my team to accomplish.

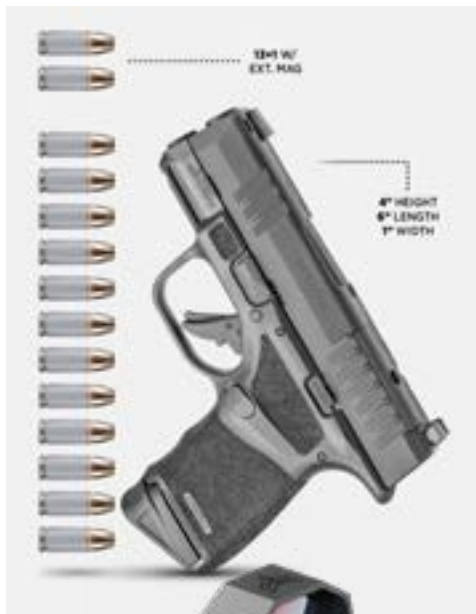
