Also, I will still have a Day of Grace on April 8 of Holy Week when I am in both parish confessionals for most of the day. I will be in the Sacred Heart confessional from 9:30 a.m. until Noon. I will be in the St. Joseph confessional from 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. The Penance Service scheduled for Palm Sunday has been cancelled.

Perhaps you've heard the saying- "Tough times don't last, but tough people do." Let us ask the Lord to make us tough with His grace, love and mercy and we will achieve victory!
