



## Scholarship

Scholarship is being established by Rocky Mountain Chuckwagon Association (RMCA) in 2015 to recognize the academic accomplishments of children of RMCA members, fans, sponsors and Clearwater County Residents to assist and encourage further education. One scholarship of \$1,000 is granted each year to the application.

### Scholarship Application Guidelines

#### Eligibility Requirements

Applicant must:

- Be a Canadian citizen and a resident of Clearwater County.
- Be planning to enroll in the first or second year of a post-secondary program of at least two years in length.
- Preferably a volunteer or member of RMCA will be given a preference.
- Financial requirement
- Highest marks in graduation year won't be a priority.

In addition, applicants must include:

- An essay describing their study plans and future career goals. The essay should be typed, double-spaced and no longer than 1,000 words.
- A copy of their post-secondary institution acceptance letter.
- Official Government of Alberta transcripts (once available).
- Two letters of reference either from teachers, employers, coaches, or mentor. The letter should describe the qualities the applicant displays which make them an appropriate candidate for this award. For example the

letter may include information regarding the applicant's achievement in extracurricular activities or community involvement.

### **Selection Procedure**

Recipients will be chosen by Directors of RMCA. Applicants will be judged on their Volunteerism w RMCA & Community, essay, letters of reference and financial requirements.

### **Application Procedure**
