Re-ENGAGE

- Targets: Engage and Unite chapters Reach out to assist with best practices
- Results:
 - o Have visited 15 chapters thus far

- Most recently *Presented DBCF POWER INITIATIVE & Implementation* presentation in Osceola and Miami Dade
- Developed and Shared "Vote the Whole Ballot" slate card format and used in 9 counties in 2018 VoteTheWholeBallot.com
 - o Brevard, Lake, Okaloosa, Orange, Osceola, Pinellas, Polk, Seminole, Volusia
 - o Goal to expand card to at least 30 counties in 2020 election cycle
- Drafted bereavement memos for dearly departed members, as well as supportive memos for members under political attack.
- Assisted and advised chapters in completing certification documents, doing audits, organizing civic functions, hosting fundraisers

- Developed "5 Reasons for Joining DBCF" and "5 Reasons for being a Democrat" list – both adopted by DBCF at Executive Council Meeting
