RESOLUTION 64-13 TOWN BOARD APPROVED THE ADOPTION OF THESE CHANGES TO THE EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK.

Proposed Changes to the Employee Handbook (Subject to Board Approval)

Section 2.01 Probationary Period

- -Sick time will begin to accrue on Day 1 of employment, but may not be used until the probation period has ended (6 months).
- -Vacation begins to accrue on Day 1 of employment, but may not be used until one year of employment has been reached (anniversary date)
- -Personal time will begin to accrue on Day 1 of employment and And can be used be at any time (subject to Supervisor's approval)

Section 4.02 Health Insurance

-Unmarried children of an employee can be covered under the employee's health insurance plan up to age 26

- -If an employee chooses to opt-out of the Town's Health Insurance Plan, he/she must provide proof of coverage under another plan, and submit in writing their willingness to forego the Health Insurance. If all criteria are met, the employee is eligible for \$2,500.00 reimbursement, payable in December of the calendar year in which the application is made. The Town will NOT prorate reimbursement; the employee must be employed for the entire calendar year to be eligible.
- -Retirement Health Insurance: eligibility based on Twenty Five (25) consecutive years of service as an employee of the Town, and must be at least age 55 to receive retirement benefits under the provisions of the New York State Retirement System

Section 4.04 Vacation

-The maximum number of hours allowed to "carry over" is 80 hours per calendar year, and will be capped at 280 hours

Section 4.05 Sick Time

-Upon retirement, unused sick time can be used/converted to COBRA payments for up to six (6) months for the employee and/or employee's spouse

Section 4.07 Worker's Compensation and on-the-job accidents

-Drug testing is mandatory after an accident

Section 4.08 Personal Leave

- -Employees will be permitted to take personal leave in two (2) hour increments
- -Unused personal time on December 31st will be carried forward as sick time in the new calendar year

Section 4.09 Compensation

- -Must be approved by immediate supervisor
- -Comp time will be capped at 80 hours per calendar year
- -Comp time accrues at the rate of time-and-a-half
- -Comp time must be used within the calendar year it is earned, or will be paid to the employee at REGULAR pay

* The section on sick time noting that unused sick hours may be converted into COBRA benefits, will need to be revisited. The current schedule only allows for single coverage, the Board indicated that time may also be used for spouse coverage and we will need to set up the conversion table to allow for current pricing on both plans.
