Pricing

The cost of quilting is figured out by total square inches. Estimate the cost for the quilting of your top by multiplying the measurements across the width of the quilt and the length of the top to figure out the total square inches. For example, if your quilt is 50"x60", you multiply 50x60=3000 total square inches, with simple edge to edge quilting, the cost would be 3000x.02=\$60. The cost for custom or high density quilting would be 3000x.035=\$105.

- ♦ .02 cents per square inch Simple edge to edge designs, light to medium
 - ♦ .035 cents per square inch High Density edge to edge
 - ♦ .035 & up depending on complexity Custom quilting services
- ** Minimum quilting charge is \$50

Thread charge \$8 for first color, extra colors are \$4 each

Additional Services Available

Preparing Quilt Top

There are various steps to ensuring a great look of your quilt top, removal of extra threads, making sure the top and backing are properly pressed and squared. You will be charged \$10 per item if the items need to be prepared prior to quilting.

Trimming quilts: (After quilting)

Small (baby, twin)	\$10
Medium (full-queen)	\$15
King	\$20

Binding quilts

Machine sewn on front only	.20 per linear inch
Machine sewn front & back	.25 per linear inch
Machine sewn front, hand sewn top	.35 per linear inch

Backing

Piecing seams for backing \$10

Additional Important Information

Please make sure backing is 4 inches larger than the quilt top, on all 4 sides. This additional fabric is needed for attaching the quilt to the longarm machine. For example, the backing fabric for a 50"x60" quilt top would need to be 58"x68".
