RE: Riding on Fire Trucks

Please note that it has always been our policy at VFIS to discourage individuals other than members from riding on fire apparatus for safety reasons. In addition, we feel if the insured allows individuals other than members to ride on the apparatus, they are leaving themselves wide open for a possible lawsuit. Therefore, we recommend that our insured's allow NO ONE other than members to ride on the fire apparatus.

However, the automobile policy does not specifically exclude coverage for this situation and would not require an endorsement. If someone were to be injured while riding on one of the apparatus their own personal (or parents in the event the individual is a minor) medical payments coverage would be primary. In order for the department's liability coverage to respond the claimant would have to establish that our insured was negligent and therefore, responsible for the injuries.

Thank you for your inquiry and I hope you understand the stance that VFIS has chosen to take regarding this issue.
